To ask the Minister for Health the location of Health Service Executive treatment centres for patients diagnosed as requiring Tier 4 Residential Addiction Treatment.

PQ 6843/16

* To ask the Minister for Health the cost by week of treating a patient within a Tier 4 Residential Addiction Treatment Centre.

PQ 6846/16

* To ask the Minister for Health the cost of referring patients to private or voluntary Tier 4 Addiction Treatment Centres, in each of the past five years.

Dear Deputy Adams,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Questions which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position:

The table at Appendix 1 outlines Tier 4 services that are provided directly by the HSE or agencies that are in receipt of funding from the HSE. The table details the Community Health Organisation (CHO) area in which the Tier 4 service is located, the number of beds in the service and the nature of the service provided. Access to all Tier 4 services is based on need rather than geographical location.

In regard to the cost of referring patients to Tier 4 services, this information is not readily available as where HSE funding is provided to a Tier 4 service, it is done in one or more of the following ways:

- On a "per bed allocation" with all treatment episodes associated with that bed given to HSE referrals, an example being HSE funding for 6 beds in Aislinn and or Cuan Mhuire Detoxification service.
- On a "per treatment basis" where each treatment is paid for separately.

 On a "staffing cost basis" In some cases funding has been given to pay for a number of staff salaries within a service an example being Regional Drugs Task Force funding for MQI. This varies across HSE regions and within service level agreements.

However the current HSE calculated breakeven costs per client for accessing each of the types of residential Tier 4 service is outlined at Appendix 2.

The cost of a treatment episode varies dependent on the type of residential service, namely, Short Stay, Long Stay, Therapeutic Community, Adolescent Unit or Medical Detox Unit. The difference can be because of the service duration, age of the clients and/or the therapy programme provided. However, within each of the types, there can also be differences in the service provided due to duration, clinical mix, therapy programme or number of beds. These differences affect the overall cost of one place on a treatment programme.
