To ask the Minister for Health the number of detoxification beds for persons recovering from addiction by county; the number of rehabilitation beds for persons recovering from addiction by county in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Howlin,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position:

Table 1 below outlines the location and type of community based residential detoxification beds/ Detoxification Units Beds. For the Deputy's information access to community based detoxification services is based on need rather than geographical location.

^[2] Note there are an additional 6.5 Stabilisation beds that can be used interchangeably depending on need for detoxification within the Medical Detoxification Units.

(These are the most recent figures available from 2017). Access to all Tier 4 services is based on need rather than geographical location.
