Dear Deputy Gould,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position:

Re number of beds currently open and number of beds available, please see the attached Table 1 listing the number of beds available as at September 2021 in residential addiction services provided directly by the HSE or Agencies that are in receipt of funding from the HSE, by Community Health Organisation (CHO) Area.

Re the number of episodes purchased in 2020 and 2021, where HSE funding is provided to a Tier 4 service, it can vary across HSE regions and within service level agreements. It is done in one or more of the following ways: on a 'per bed allocation', on a 'per treatment basis' where each treatment is paid for separately, or on a facility/staffing cost basis.

Additionally, the National Social Inclusion Office purchases treatment episodes annually. This amounted to €2.05m in 2020 and €3.175m for 2021.

Re the length of a treatment episode, this varies per service. For example for medical detoxification, the duration of treatment ranges from 28 to 56 days and short stay residential rehabilitation can range from 28 to 42 days.
