**To ask the Minister for Health the total number of drug detox beds within the State public health system; and if she will make a statement on the matter.**

Dear Deputy Stanley,

The Health Service Executive have been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The provision of a detoxification programme to an individual occurs after a comprehensive medical assessment. In some cases, it may be appropriate to provide the detoxification in a community setting, either via a GP or a HSE addiction clinic.

Table 1 below lists the number of beds available as of November 2025 in residential addiction services, including detoxification services provided directly by the HSE or Agencies that receive funding from the HSE, by County.
