Summary of Board Leading Practices in Improving Quality and Safety

Leadership for Improving Quality & Safety Actively demonstrating a commitment to seek assurance and drive improvement

- Board ensures there is a clear vision, goal and strategy for quality and safety.
- Board provides visible leadership in developing a positive culture for the organisation.
- Some board members are recruited with clinical quality and safety expertise.
- Board advises and requests action on quality and safety of care matters.

Practices for Improving Quality &

Safety

Making quality and safety of care a priority of the boards business

- Board identifies and authorises board terms of reference with a focus on assuring quality and safety.
- Board provides induction and orientation in quality and safety structures for new board members.
- Board prioritises and allocates time on the board agenda to discuss quality and safety.
- Board plans and receives training and development in quality and safety.

Partnerships for Improving Quality & Safety Developing strong collaborative partnerships with staff and service users and the wider community

 Board has the mechanism for direct engagement with service users, staff and wider community.

Methods for Improving Quality & Safety

Supporting the provider in applying a quality improvement methodology

 Board approves resources and oversees quality improvement programme selected by the executive. 5

Measurement for Improving Quality & Safety Selecting board measures to monitor and demonstrate an improvement in the delivery of care

- Board reviews quality and safety information (dashboards, reports).
- Board advises and requests actions for improvement of quality and safety of care.

Risk Management & Assurance Ensuring all risks to service user quality and safety are addressed in a robust and structured way

- Board seeks assurance of quality and safety of care.
- Board monitors and oversees risks to quality and safety of care.

Planning for Improving Quality & Safety Championing and overseeing the development, implementation and monitoring of a plan for improving quality and safety

- Board guides the Executive in the development of Quality and Safety Plan.
- Board approves the Quality and Safety Plan.
- Board supports the organisation in celebrating the key milestones and successes.
