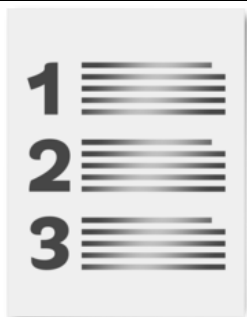

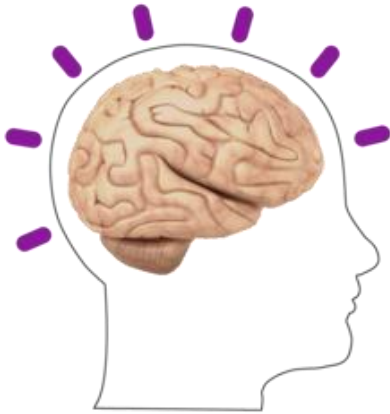

# What is the National Intellectual Disability Memory Service?



As people get older, their brains can start to change.

It is important to know if there are any changes happening in our brain.



If people have concerns about their memory they can go to the National ID Memory Service clinic.



The Memory Service is at Tallaght University Hospital where you will get help.

# What will happen at my appointment?



The nurse will ask you some questions about your health and memory.



The nurse will ask you to do some puzzles to test your memory.

The support person will help you with the puzzles.



The nurse will talk to your family or keyworker too.



We may make an appointment with you to check your blood pressure



We may do some blood tests.



We may also check your heart beat.

This is called an ECG.



The doctor will talk with you about your memory concerns.



You may need to get a CT scan to check your brain.

The nurse will talk to you about this.

# Where is the National Intellectual Disability Memory Service?



The National ID Memory Service is in the Russell Building, Floor 7, at Tallaght University Hospital, in Dublin



Take the Lift to Floor 7 (located behind reception)

The nurse will meet you at Floor 7.



Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your appointment.



You may be in the Memory Clinic for up to 2-3 hours. You can go for a coffee and lunch in a local café if you want.
