

How to Set up a Diabetes Register using Medicom/ Dynamic GP

Where a practice is using the ICPC-2 Codes

- 1 **Main Menu**
- 2 **Reports – Medical Report,**
- 3 In next screen written in **blue** *Medical History ICPC 2* click on box ‘**activate ICPC**’
- 4 Drop down type in illness e.g. for Diabetes. Two options come up and double click
 - o *T89 Diabetes insulin dependent* (**NB.** Please use T89 for Type I Diabetes only, not Type II who have moved on to insulin)
 - o *T90 Diabetes non-insulin dependent*
 - o *W85 Gestational Diabetes*
- 5 Click on **Results**
- 6 **Name Report**
- 7 Click on **Save Report**
- 8 Report will be added to bottom of your list of **Medical Reports**

Note: Two dates will come up one being today’s date and the other is defaulted to 3 years, change to when started coding patients

Identifying Patients from Medications

Find under **medications**

- 9 **Main Menu**
 - 10 **Reports – Medical Report,**
- In next screen written in blue
- 1 **Medications – activate drugs**
 - 2 List uses Generics
 - 3 Can select more than one drug at a time
 - 4 Click on **Results**
 - 5 **Name Report**
 - 6 Click on **Save Report**
 - 7 Report will be added to bottom of your list of **Medical Reports**

Entering ICPC-2 Codes

- 1 **Patient Registration Page**
- 2 Click on **Medical History**
- 2 In Box, **type in Diabetes**
- 3 **Dropdown box** will show all ICPC-2 Codes
 - o *T89 Diabetes Insulin Dependant*
 - o *T90 non insulin dependant*

- 4 **Double Click** to confirm

Note: This is normally done by GP.

Maintenance of the Register

- 1 Record RIPs, patients who have left the practice, visitors, etc. on a regular basis.

What next?

- 2** Use the register to ensure all patients are called e.g. Flu Vaccines
- 3 The DIAMOND list held in the Diabetes Centre at UHG for your practice will be sent out to you for verification.
