

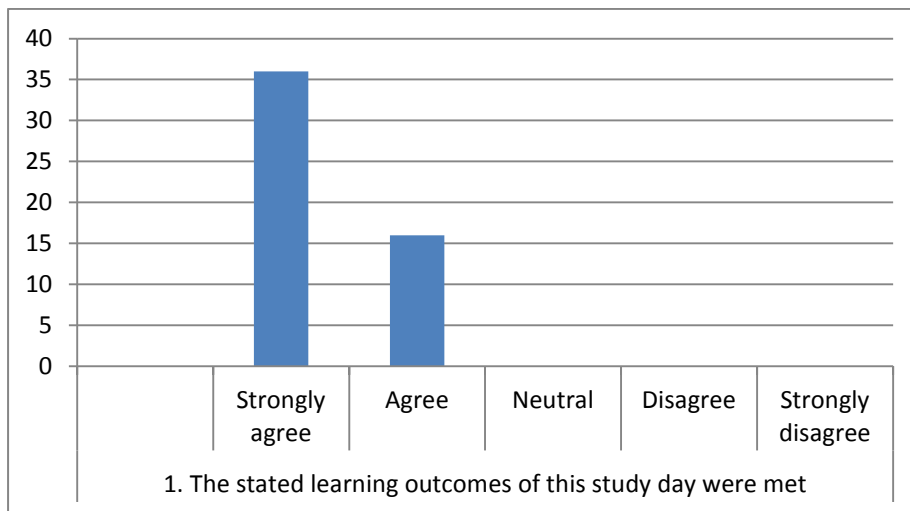
Evaluation / Feedback from the Joint BW & Health Training Day

The feedback to the questions is given below.

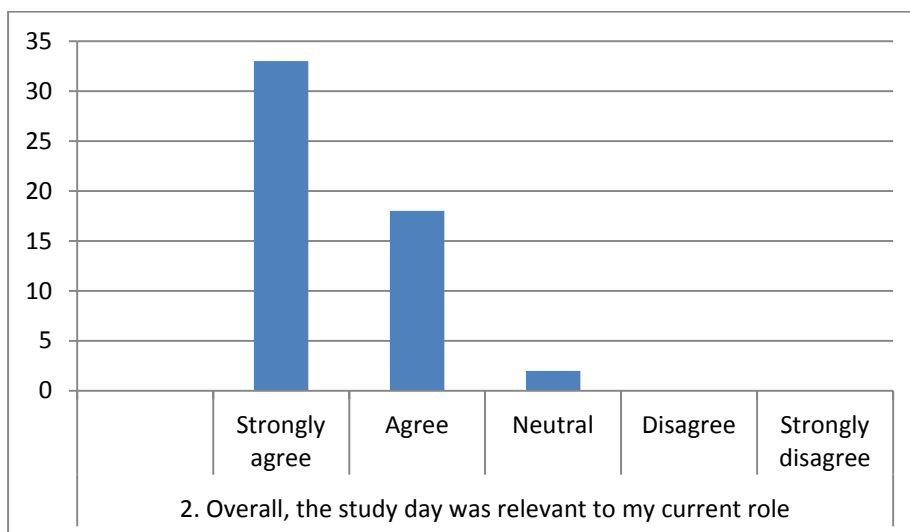

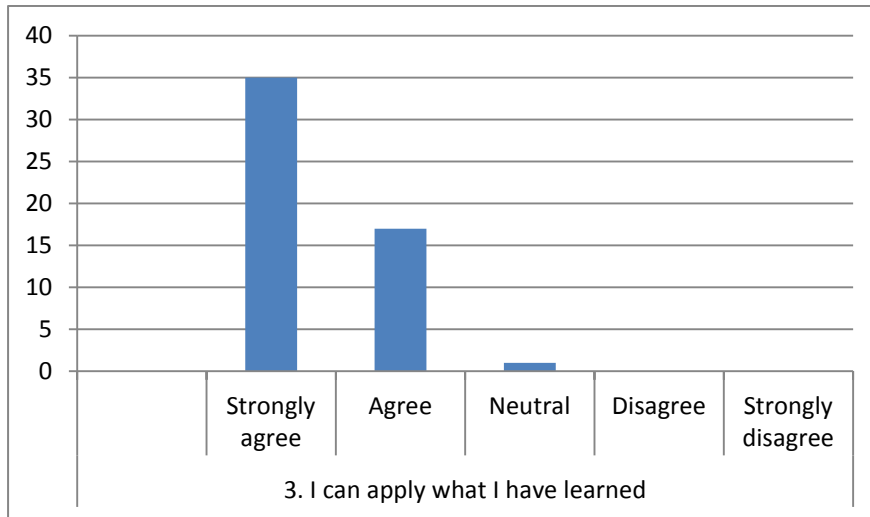

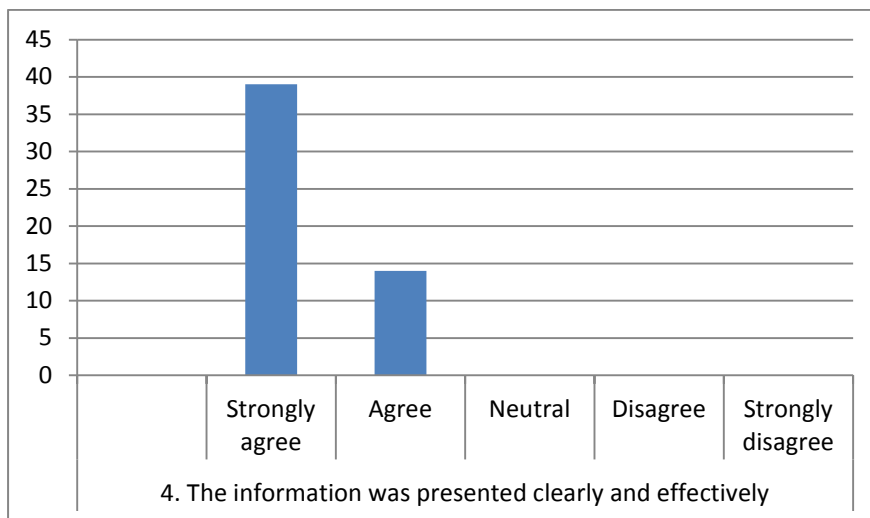

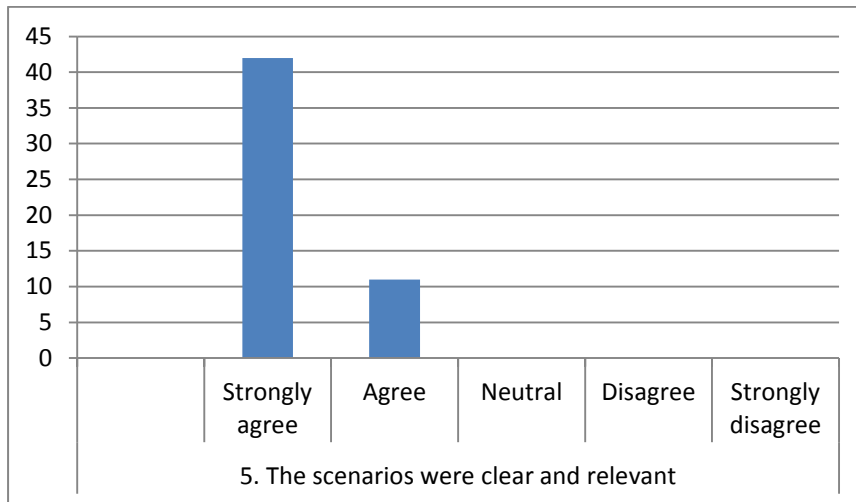

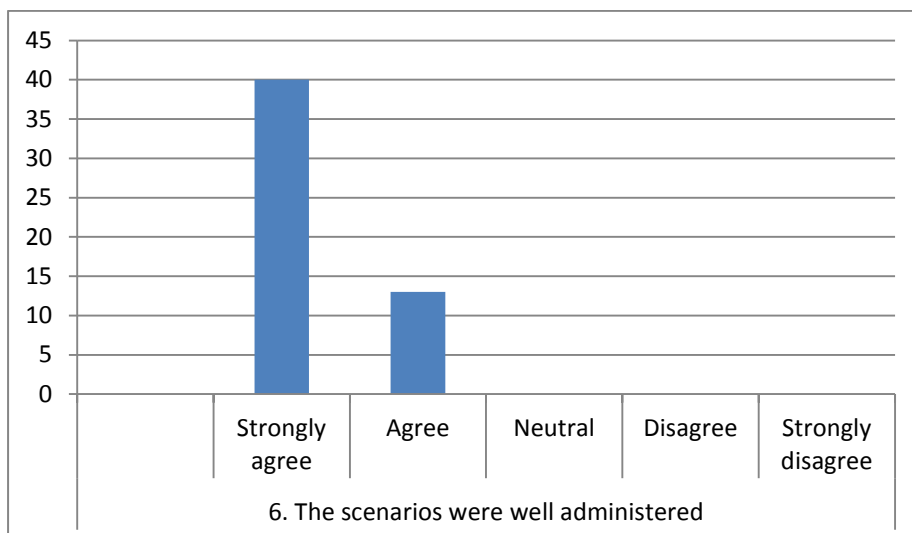

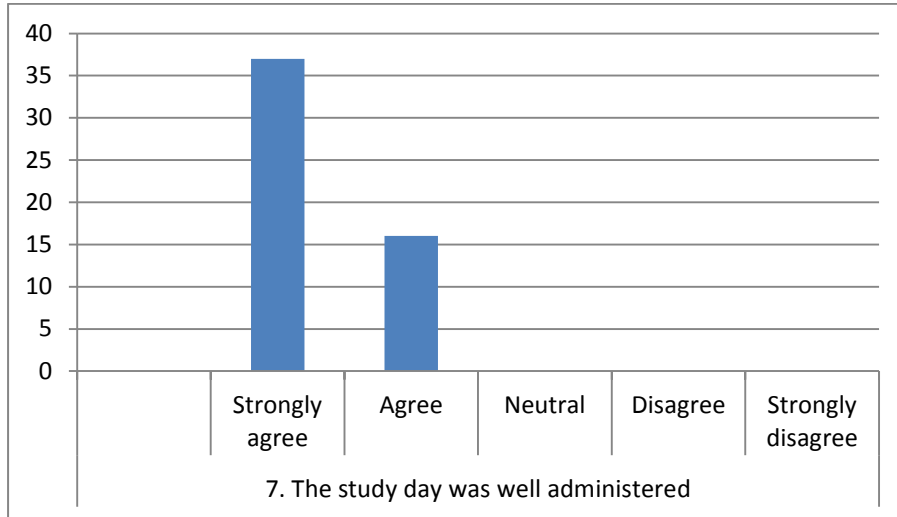
