Reactions that can sometimes happen after getting MenC vaccine include:

- Soreness, swelling and redness where the injection was given (this usually passes after a day or two)
- Irritability (in infants and toddlers)
- Headache

Occasionally you/your child may feel sick or have a mild fever.

You/your child can take paracetamol or ibuprofen to relieve aches and pains or to lower the fever. If you are concerned about yourself/your child please seek medical advice.

If you require medical advice please contact your GP.

Before the next vaccine, you should contact the vaccination team if there has been:

- a serious reaction to the vaccine
- any change to you/your child's medical history or your consent.
