Schedule changes

Reasons for Hep B vaccine

- Serious disease
- Safe, effective vaccine
- Fits into schedule

Reasons for Pneumococcal (PCV) vaccine

- Common illness, potentially serious
- Safe, effective vaccine
- Fits into schedule

Reasons for Adolescent Pertussis vaccine

- Burden of disease
- Safe, effective vaccine
- Fits into schedule

Schedule 2007

- Birth BCG
- 2mths DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB +PCV
- 4mths DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB +MenC
- 6mths DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB +PCV +MenC

- 12mths MMR + PCV
- 13mths MenC +Hib

- 4-5yrs DTaP/IPV + MMR
- 11-14yrs Tdap
