Re: Seasonal Influenza (Flu) Vaccination Campaign 2016/2017

Dear Chief Executive,

Flu is a serious viral illness that can spread rapidly and the best way to prevent it is by vaccination.

Seasonal influenza (flu) vaccination reduces infection and associated illnesses, hospitalisation and even prevents deaths.

Every year flu vaccination is strongly recommended for pregnant women and health care workers as well as people with long term medical conditions.

Flu vaccine is particularly important for pregnant women as they and their babies are at risk of complications from the disease. High vaccine uptakes rates among staff have been shown to reduce the serious impact of flu among patients.

I would be grateful if you would **arrange for all your health care workers and carers to be vaccinated** and **ensure their vaccine status is documented** and **encourage your patients to be vaccinated**.
