

Games for Babies: Fun with Stuff!

Rocket in a Box

Get into a large cardboard box and make a rocket sound and finish with 'Lift off!!!' and jump out!



Bubbles!

Blow bubbles and allow your baby to pop them. Wait for your baby to show she wants more with eye contact, a sound, a gesture and blow again!



Can you find me?

Lie your baby somewhere comfortable, stand over them with a large scarf or light sheet. Lightly cover your baby with the sheet and lift it. Smile and say 'There you are!' Cover your baby and go again!

Remember: Never leave a baby's head covered up with a blanket.



Cardboard Tubes!

Use the cardboard inner rolls of kitchen paper to play 'I spy' or play the drums or make sounds down the tube.



Spray Play!

Fill a **clean** spray bottle or water pistol with lukewarm water and spray your baby's bare feet for some water fun.



Mirror, Mirror

Hold your baby in your arms so he's facing a mirror, or let your baby sit in front of a mirror and explore.



Home Made Puppets

Use old socks to make puppets (draw faces on socks with markers or nail polish) and use the puppets to talk to your baby.



Water Fun

Let your baby play with a sink/basin of water and suds!

Remember: Never leave a baby alone while playing with water.
