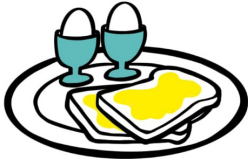

We would like to help you through these days. Here are some tips and information we would like to share with you.



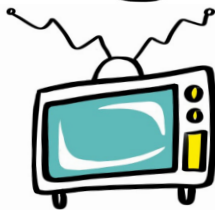
Keep to a Routine
