

HSE AMRIC Antimicrobial Classification for Hospitals

Local antimicrobial guidelines, where possible, recommend green antimicrobials as first line therapy

Green (access) Antimicrobials

Lower risk of AMR, first line
antimicrobials, fewer side effects

Amber (watch) Antimicrobials

Higher risk of AMR, more
adverse effects

Red (reserve) Antimicrobials

Higher risk of AMR, last resort
antimicrobials, prescribed on the
advice of infection specialist only

Cefiderocol	Imipenem/Cilastatin
Ceftaroline	Linezolid
Ceftazidime/Avibactam	Meropenem/Vaborbactam
Ceftolozane/Tazobactam	Moxifloxacin
Colistin	Meropenem
Dalbavancin	Minocycline IV
Daptomycin	Oritavancin
Delafloxacin	Rifampicin
Ertapenem	Streptomycin
Fidaxomicin	Tigecycline

Antifungal

Liposomal amphotericin B (TD)	Isavuconazole
Anidulafungin	Posaconazole (TD)
Caspofungin (TD)	Voriconazole (TD)
Flucytosine	*TD=Treatment Dose

Ganciclovir
