**Details:**

Dear Colleagues,

The daily cut off time for receipt of specimens in the laboratory is 5pm on Mondays to Thursdays and **3pm on a Friday**. This is to ensure that all specimens from primary care are received and resulted within the laboratory core hours, allowing notification of any critical results or results requiring attention to the requesting clinician prior to 8pm. This is especially critical on Fridays, as should samples arrive late there are no routine staff present on Saturdays to perform testing thus samples are left until Monday meaning that certain critical time sensitive assays will not be performed.

From September 1<sup>st</sup> we will only be accepting Electronic reports from Biomnis. This means that all GP samples will be reported electronically via Healthlink. All results will be available to Gp's via the Biomnis website.
