During your stay at St. Columcille's Hospital a team of nurses led by the Clinical Nurse Manager will care for you. They will provide a high standard of nursing care and will endeavour to meet your individual needs.

The Clinical Nurse Manager on your ward will try to assign the same nursing staff to care for you.

Your nurse(s) will introduce themselves to you. All nursing staff wear name badges. However if at any stage you forget the name of your nurse or you are unsure please ask.

The Registered nurses may be assisted in their work by Health Care Assistants.

We also have a number of Clinical Nurse Specialists in the Nursing department and you may have reason to meet one of these during your stay at St. Columcille's. These nurses will always introduce themselves to you.

St. Columcille's hospital nursing department also provides clinical learning placements to BSc nursing students from University College Dublin and Trinity College Dublin.

Uniforms:
