

St. Anne's Ward

St. Anne's ward is a 36 bedded unit on the ground floor with access to patients' garden consisting of raised beds and seating areas that can be used all year round.

St. Anne's provides specialist medical service for:

- Stroke rehabilitation
- Orthopaedic rehabilitation
- Weight management
- General medicine.

The rooms on the ward are 4, 3 or 2 bedded areas and 1 single room generally used for infection control purposes. The rooms are labelled A to K. The main nurses' station is situated in the middle of the ward and there are satellite nurses' stations at either end of the ward. The Day room/meeting room is located at the end of the ward.

St. Anne's is ideally located next to the canteen which is open to patients and visitors.

St. Anne's Staff are a highly dedicated team consisting of a Clinical Nurse Manager 2, Clinical Nurse Manager 1, staff nurses, health care assistants, ward clerk and household personnel.

St. Anne's operates a protected meal time policy for all patient meals and visiting is from 2pm to 4pm and 6.30pm to 8.30pm. Visiting outside these hours is at the discretion of the Nurse in Charge.
