The Haemovigilance Officer is located on the first floor (Level B) of the Regional Hospital Mullingar.

Haemovigilance plays a vital role in promoting high quality and safe standards for all aspects of blood transfusion practice. This role is supported by the implementation of the EU Blood Directives (2002/98/EC) and (2005/61/EC) which have been enacted into Irish legislation (SI 360/2005 and SI 547/2006). The Regional Hospital Mullingar Haemovigilance Service has been accredited since June 2008 and undergoes an annual inspection by the Irish National Accreditation Board for compliance with legislation and international standard: ISO 15189.
