

Speech and Language Department

Our Location:

The Speech and Language Therapy (SLT) Department is located in the Ash Unit on the second floor (Level C) of the Regional Hospital Mullingar.

Our Services:

The Speech and Language Therapists work as part of a multi-disciplinary team to offer an assessment and therapy service to adult inpatients hospital wide with communication, swallowing and / or voice disorders. These difficulties may be as a result of a stroke, head injury, progressive neurological disorders, elderly care, dementia, cancer, post surgery or due to other causes. The focus is on acute care including diagnosis and early management of these difficulties. Patients may be referred to the community SLT service after discharge from hospital if follow-up is required. The SLT Department at the Regional Hospital Mullingar does not currently provide an outpatient service.

A regular Videofluoroscopy clinic is provided by a team of Speech and Language Therapists, Radiologist and Radiographer in the Radiology department to assess swallowing function in patients with swallowing disorders.
