♦ These figures include obstetric events presenting to the General Hospital in UHL. Heretofore, only UMHL figures were included. They are particularly reflective of pulmonary embolisms and give a more accurate return of data. This is likely to raise our figures when compared to hospitals not returning data inclusive of general hospitals. The data includes only patients who have been booked at UMHL, including emergency transfers to UMHL. The figures do not include unbooked patients who present directly to UHL in the first instance.
