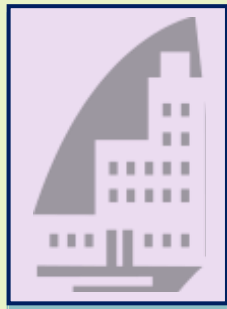


Progress made under Time to Move on from Congregated Settings by end of 2017

32 Years

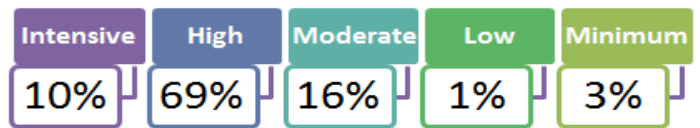
Average length of time the people who transitioned had spent living in congregated settings



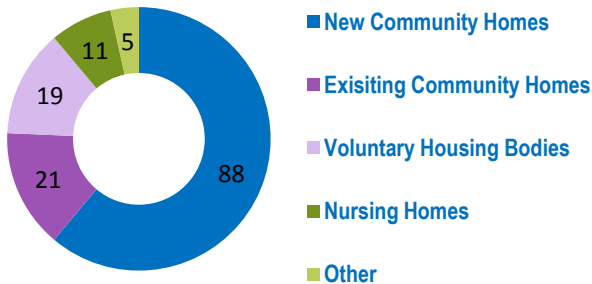
51 years of age
