Implementation of Interim Standards – Update

- Those day service locations that have completed their full evaluation of Themes 1-7 can upload the National Report to www2.hse.ie/apps/formdssagii.aspx.
- For those that have not completed Themes 1-7, we will extend the completion date until end of November.
- Support materials will be developed to assist in enabling providers to include service users in the EASI Process during the resumption of services / new ways of working.

- It is important that day services continue on the action plans they have completed and use those as live documents to support the resumption planning for day services. These plans will be of huge benefit to maintain and support quality services as new ways of working are developed.
