2016

- The New Directions Benchmarking exercise completed by all day service providers indicated the need to develop and implement a common understanding and approach to Person-Centred Planning.

2018

- Person-Centred Planning Framework developed and signed off.

2019

- PCP Framework Demonstration Project completed with five Service Provider Organisations.

2020

- Report of Demonstration Project published.

Plan Going Forward

Roll out Framework to all day services:

- April to June 2021 - Webinars to introduce and explain the PCP Framework.
- By End of December 2021 – All Service Providers should have self-evaluated to establish if their practice is in line with the Framework.
- 1st Quarter 2022 - All Service Providers to develop plans to address alignment to the Framework.

Additional guidance is currently being finalised to address topics identified in the Demonstration project such as:

- Circles of Support
- Understanding the difference between the person-centred plan and personalised care and support plans
- Developing a good person-centred plan
- Goal setting.

- All Day Service Location Managers should discuss the National framework for PCP implementation with their Day Service Team.
