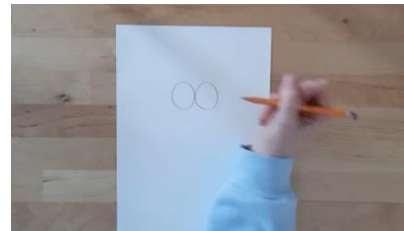

You will need:

- White paper
- Pencil
- Rubber

1. Draw two circles. These will be the eyes.



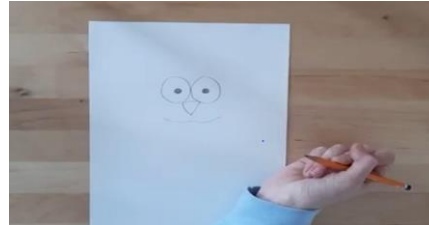
2. Draw two smaller circles in the middle of the eyes.



3. Draw an upside down triangle beneath the eyes. This is the beak.



4. Draw a dot under the beak.
Draw a curved line to the dot and
then repeat the other side.



5. Draw a curved lined around the
face to made the owls head.



6. Draw two triangles and a curved
line between them on the top and
bottom of the head.



7. Draw two curved lines that meet
each other either side of the owl.
These will be the wings.



8. At the edge of the wings, draw
three semi circles, each side.
These are the feet.



9. You can draw a crooked line to make a branch.

10. In the centre of the owl, draw lots of w's to make the feathers.
