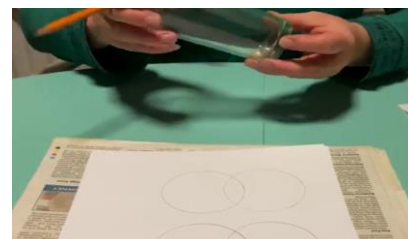

You will need:

- Newspaper
- Plain white paper
- Paintbrush
- Water
- Plate
- Kitchen Towel
- Pencil
- Rubber
- Paints: Blue, red and yellow
- Glass or cup

1. Place the glass on the page.  
Draw three sets of two, overlapping circles.



2. Place your three paint colours on the plate.



3. The first set of circles:

Paint the first circle yellow.

Then for the overlapping piece, mix yellow and red and paint. This makes orange.

The last circle will be painted red.



4. The second set of circles:

Paint the first circle yellow.

Mix yellow and blue paint and paint the overlapping piece. This colour makes green.

The paint the last circle blue.



5. The third set of circles:

Paint the first circle red.

Mix red and blue paint and paint the overlapping piece. This colour will make purple.

Paint the last circle blue.
