The third and final deep dive meetings have been scheduled for September 1st and 2nd. DigiCan Train <ul style="list-style-type: none"> DigiCan Train is a project that focuses on digital skills for cancer nursing. The project is progressing and has passed the mid-term report.

Recruitment is underway for a replacement Consultant General Surgeon with a special interest in breast surgery at Letterkenny University Hospital. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Implementation of centralisation plans is ongoing. RPLND – process is ongoing in relation to the designation of a national centre for RPLND surgery. Pelvic Exenteration – update awaited on new UK standards and guidelines which are expected to be published later this month. Skull base – work is ongoing with clinicians around structure of MDT meetings. Gynae-oncology – A joint MDT on NCIS has been set up between Galway and University Hospital Limerick. Head and neck – discussions are taking place regarding the Waterford service.

	<p><u>Systemic Therapy Programme (STP)/Cancer Drug Management Programme (CDMP)/Molecular</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drug approvals: three new indications for drugs were approved May 1st 2025 – Olaparib and Lipegfilgrastim • NCCP Pharmacist Competencies (Cancer Care) Working Group: 1st meeting took place at the end of April. • Molecular: Testing guidance for Medical Oncologists on testing to support prescribing of PARPi has been updated to include testing for new indications for olaparib in early Breast Cancer and metastatic pancreatic cancer. • Peripheral systemic anti-cancer treatment clinics: consideration to be given how best to support the delivery of care at these hospitals and transfer pathways in instances where acute medical or surgical care is required. <p>Action: To be discussed with HSE Chief Clinical Officer</p>	R. 	<p>Roll-out continuing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 21 of 26 hospitals live - including 7 of the 9 cancer centres. - Wexford General Hospital and Tallaght University Hospital are progressing with implementation projects. - University Hospital Waterford go-live date is planned for the end of May. - Midlands Regional Hospital Tullamore re-commenced use of NCIS in Pharmacy with support from NCIS Office. - PID for Mater Misericordiae University Hospital is under review. - Work on Orchestra (NCIS Communication Bus) has commenced. Project is expected to take 8-10 weeks. - Discussions on PAS to NCIS interface is in progress. - Portiuncula Hospital is experiencing a challenge in resourcing the project. 	
E6	Radiation Oncology (F. Bonas/C. Faul)	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • KPI performance has improved due to improved staffing levels and the introduction of hypofractionation protocols. • Cyberattack Preparedness - work on this project is nearing completion. • Artificial Intelligence (AI) group – the group has completed a national survey of all centres to identify where centres are in terms of AI developments. • Radioligand – the first meeting of the NCCP group has taken place. Data is currently being reviewed. • A rectal spacer pilot project has recently been completed and patient feedback is being collated. • Work is ongoing with Radiation Therapists and Physicists to agree a national definition of a closed linac. • SABRE SRS is now available to some extent in all three radiation centres (Cork, Dublin and Galway). Group to be formed to plan for future service development. • A project has commenced in collaboration with Urologists and Radiation Oncologists regarding informed patient choice. • Altnagelvin contract is currently under review. • UPMC contract – process has been completed. • Limerick – awaiting communication from the REO on next steps.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The importance of cancer network meetings was highlighted, in particular their usefulness as a forum for the discussion of finance and performance issues relating to regions. NCCP to progress with scheduling of cancer review meetings pending the formalisation of the proposed MOU with Health Regions.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cancer risk population profiles are being developed for each health region on cancer prevention.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Acute haematology oncology nursing service (AHOS) will mark five years in operation at a conference in September. The AHOS will be profiled by the Irish Times in an upcoming article. NCCP nursing team and NI lead nurses meeting ongoing to determine collaborative nursing initiatives. Issue of dayward staffing across some sites—measures are being implemented to mitigate the issue.
