The NCCP Community Cancer Nursing eLearning Progamme was created by the HSE's National Cancer Control Programme in conjunction with patient representatives and clinical collegues.

The programme has been formally in existence since 2011 and was delivered face to face. Due to advancements in cancer treatments, the current requirement for services have changed as more cancer treatments and services are being delivered safely in the community. This progressive suite of modules will replace the existing training in this area, refreshing the learning content and bringing the programme into an innovative, updated online format.

This programme will ensure that community-based nurses are equipped with the knowledge, skills and attitudes to safely provide care to individuals with cancer at all stages of the cancer journey.

The programme consists of 3 modules and each module has a multiple-choice exam which has a pass mark of 80%:

- Module 1: Introducing Cancer and its Effects on the Person
- Module 2: Assessing and Managing a Person with Cancer
- Module 3: Managing a Person with a Central Venous Access Device
