



NCIS GUIDE Accessing NCIS

1. Background

NCIS has 2 distinct modules, NCIS Chart and NCIS Med which are both accessed via the Citrix storefront. Depending on the users requirements they will have access to one or both of these applications.

To access NCIS users require:

- A current HealthIrl account
- An NCIS account
- 2. Logging into NCIS

Access Citrix storefront by clicking on the Store Front Shortcut (where available) or typing the web address into Internet Explorer: <u>https://storefront.healthirl.net</u>

3. Remote Access

Where a patient is having treatment managed in a different physical location the user may require remote access (for example a patient being prescribed treatment in a remote location).

Remote access is available by using the Citrix StoreFront link above. Access to Storefront is organised by the user at their remote hospital and requires local ICT to give permission.
