Managing swab results of residents with respiratory symptoms in your facility



Resident with respiratory virus symptoms



Rapid antigen detection test (RADT) for COVID-19



RADT negative



RADT positive



Send a PCR for Respiratory

Panel (maximum of 3 - 5 swabs per outbreak)



Manage as a case of

COVID-19 (send maximum of 3 - 5 PCR swabs per COVID-19 outbreak during flu



Isolate resident until the results are known



The results are in! What's next..? Are the results...

Positive for COVID-19?



- Medical review and consider antivirals
- The period of isolation is a minimum of 5 days from date of symptom onset
- Contact tracing is not required.
- No need to notify public health of single cases.

Positive for influenza?

- Medical review : Antivirals usually advised for case within 48 hours of symptom onset
- The period of isolation is a minimum of 5 days from date of symptom onset
- Identify close contacts; consider prophylactic antivirals within 48 hrs of exposure

Positive for RSV or another virus?

- Medical review if clinically unwell, sometimes elderly people with RSV need hospital.
- The period of isolation is a minimum of 5 days from date of onset of symptoms
- Contact tracing not required.

Negative or "not detected"?

- Medical review: If case was suspected influenza and is already on antivirals, a full course of treatment unless an alternative diagnosis can be established is recommended.
- Isolate until acute symptoms have resolved for 48 hours.
