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THE STI CHECKPOINT IS FOR:

GAY MEN, BISEXUAL MEN & MEN WHO HAVE SEX WITH MEN (MSM) & TRANSGENDER PEOPLE. IT IS FREE, FRIENDLY & CONFIDENTIAL.

EACH TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY EVENING WE PROVIDE;

- o Full STI Tests: (Urine Sample, Rectal and Throat Swabs) for Gonorrhoea & Chlamydia.
- o **Blood Test**: for HIV, Syphilis and Hepatitis.
- o The Hepatitis: A and B Vaccine
- o **Treatment:** for genital warts or herpes etc.
- o **PEP:** (prevention treatment for recent exposure to HIV –must be within 72 hours).
- **Counselling:** support, information and advice also available.

GMHS is a Walk-In Service for New Patients (no appointments).

The Clinic doors are open from 5.00pm to 6.30pm (we reserve the right to restrict numbers for health and safety reasons). *If you have symptoms or concerns you are requested to arrive before 6.00pm.*

Numbered forms are distributed at the front door of the hospital from 4.30pm when the GMHS waiting room is open. (WE REQUEST PATIENTS NOT TO ARRRIVE AT THE HOSPITAL BEFORE 4.30PM).

The **forms are collected** from 5.00pm and **Registration** for new patients begins at 5.30pm. **Medical Services** begin from 5.45pm. *NOTE:* this is a sexual health clinic <u>not</u> a GP service you will be referred for any other medical health matters.

The clinic can be very busy, so depending on your number, your first visit could last between one and three hours. We try to see everyone according to their number. NOTE: Other people attending this clinic will have return appointments and they will see the doctor before those with numbers. Usually our three doctors will see 10 Patients each.

Information on Your First Visit to STI Checkpoint GMHS

Please fill in the numbered TRIAGE form provided as it will help us to provide the best service for you. Completing this form means someone will talk with you, it does not guarantee a service this evening. If a doctor cannot see you at the first visit you will be offered a blood test and provided with an appointment for results and to see a doctor A member of staff will collect the forms and arrange for you to be registered.

Registration. You will be asked for your name, address and *especially your mobile telephone number*; date of birth; and where born (Country if born abroad or what County if born in Ireland). You will be asked to indicate your ethnic identity. *All of this information is confidential and kept securely. We use the mobile number to send your results by SMS or for reminders of further appointment etc.*

Reference Card: You will receive a card with your reference (chart) number, keep this safe or write your reference number somewhere or insert into your mobile phone under the name GMHS for example

After Registration: You will be directed to second waiting area to avail of the medical services. NOTE: we usually call you by your first name and the first letter of your family name.

We can provide **language translation** if needed, via telephone or in person if we are contacted 24 hours before you arrive. **An ISL Interpreter** is also available contact us by SMS (text) between 24 to 48 hours in advance to 087 941 0934.

RESULTS BY SMS DETAILS

Results are usually available in **ONE** week. We will text results on Wednesdays between 10.00am to 4.00pm. **OR** We will telephone you if there is a **REACTION** to the tests.
