Person consents to vaccination Provide person with the vaccine information & supports as required Record the person's consent in his/her healthcare record. This may be a record of a non-written (e.g. verbal or other means) consent or a consent form signed by the person Tick appropriate box in Covid Vaccination checklist Person does not consent to vaccination Provide person with the vaccine information & support as required Person communicates that they do not consent to vaccine Include note in healthcare record to reflect person's wish Tick appropriate box in Covid Vaccination checklist Person does not have capacity If the person, after receiving information and support, does not have capacity to consent, ask him/her about their NOTE: Those close to the person, such as family will and preferences regarding vaccination and seek their and friends, cannot make a decision to assent consent/ not consent on behalf of the person. If they are unable to express a clear choice: a. Ask those close to them of their likely will and preference Regardless of capacity a person cannot (i.e if they were able to do so would they agree to be be forced to have vaccine if they do not vaccinated) wish to have it Consider past behaviour as a guide to their likely will and preference c. Consider if this is for the person's benefit Make a note of the discussion in the health record signed by healthcare professional who has made decision on a benefits and will & preference basis and include details if informed by discussion with someone close to the person Tick appropriate box in Covid Vaccination checklist
