




#### Geographical Spread of COVID-19 Confirmed Cases and Suspected Cases across Acute Hospital Sites as at 16/02/2021 20:00










# Number of Confirmed COVID-19 Cases Admitted across 29 acute sites (including CHI)

Number of Confirmed COVID-19 Cases Admitted on Site at 0800hrs, 1400hrs and 2000hrs




## Percentage Variance at <u>8am</u> of Confirmed COVID-19 cases Admitted Across 29 sites compared to the previous day




# Number of Suspected COVID-19 Swab Results Awaited Across 29 acute sites as at 16/02/2021

Number of Available General Beds














