

### New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases in the Republic of Ireland as of 20th April 2020







### Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in the Republic of Ireland as at 20th April 2020




### 2000hrs, 20th April 2020: COVID-19 Dashboard by Acute Hospital


## Number of Confirmed COVID-19 cases admitted across 29 acute sites (including CHI)

Number of Confirmed COVID-19 Cases Admitted on Site at 0800hrs, 1400hrs and 2000hrs





















