




Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in the Republic of Ireland as at 22nd April 2020



Number of Confirmed COVID-19 cases admitted across 29 acute sites (including CHI)


Number of Confirmed COVID-19 Cases Admitted on Site at 0800hrs, 1400hrs and 2000hrs

Percentage increase at <u>8am</u> of Confirmed COVID-19 cases Admitted Across 29 sites compared to the previous day


% Increase at 8am of confirmed COVID-19 cases admitted across 29 sites compared to the previous day







Confirmed COVID-19 Cases in Critical Care Units




