


### New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases in the Republic of Ireland as of 19<sup>th</sup> June 2020

New COVID-19 Cases in the Republic of Ireland as of 19/06/2020





















# Number of Confirmed COVID-19 cases admitted across 29 acute sites (including CHI)















Confirmed Covid-19 Cases in Critical Care Units (19/06/2020)




