


New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases in the Republic of Ireland as of 24th April 2020





Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in the Republic of Ireland as at 24th April 2020



2000hrs, 24th April 2020: Geographical Spread of COVID-19 Confirmed Cases and Suspected Cases across Acute Hospital Sites

























