


New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases in the Republic of Ireland as at 16/09/2020





Geographical Spread of COVID-19 Confirmed Cases and Suspected Cases across Acute Hospital Sites as at 16/09/2020 20:00






Total Confirmed COVID-19 Cases (Past 24 Hours)








Number of Suspected COVID-19 Swab Results Awaited Across 29 acute sites as at 16/09/2020



Number of Available General Beds on 16/09/2020










