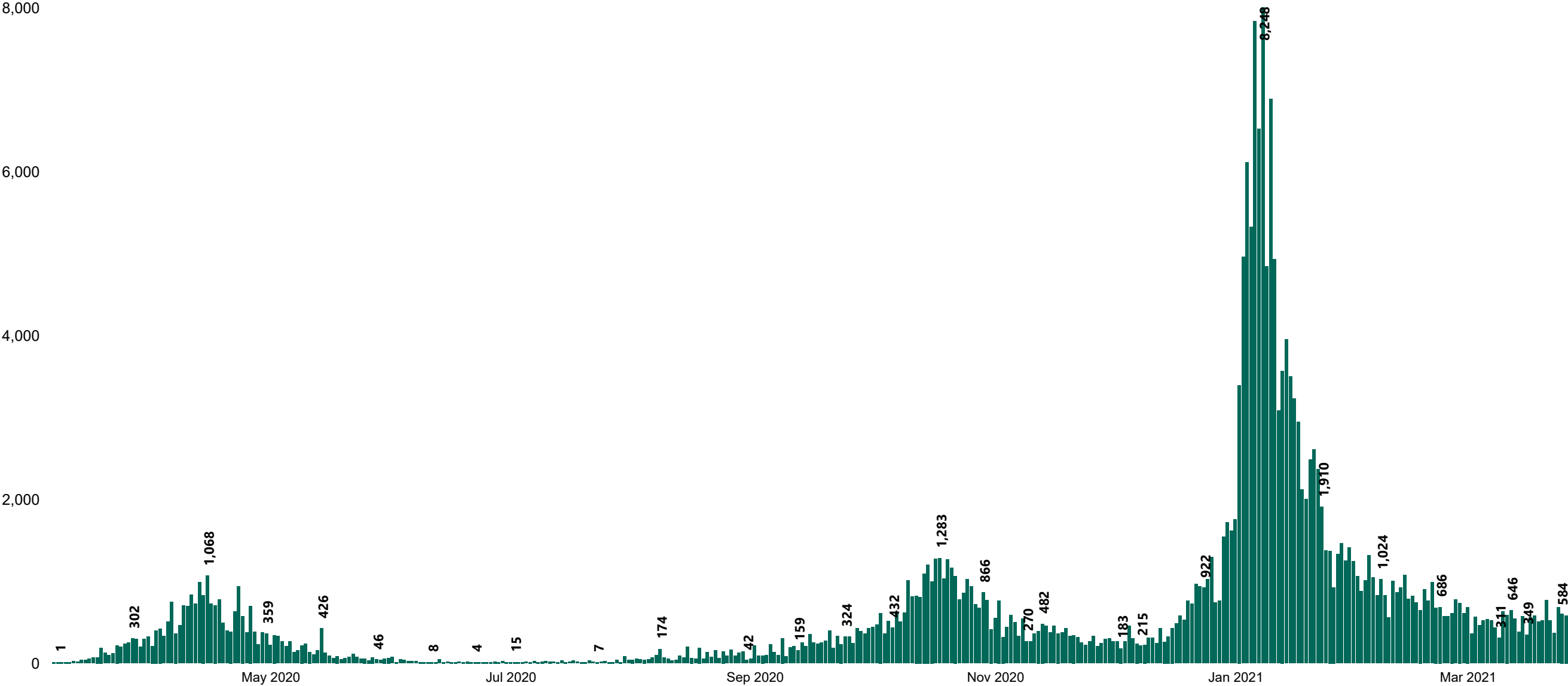

# New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases in the Republic of Ireland as at 26/03/2021

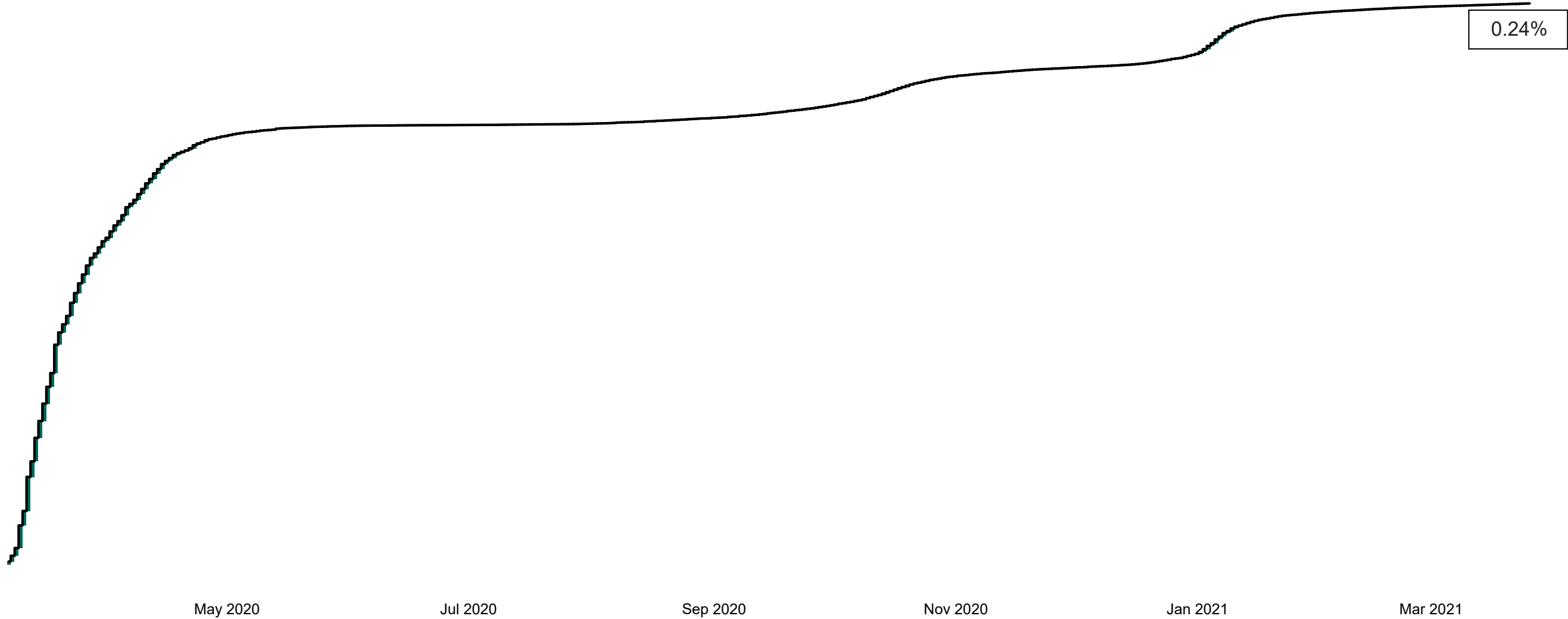
New COVID-19 Cases in the Republic of Ireland as of 26/03/2021

# Percentage Increase compared to the Previous Day as at 26/03/2021

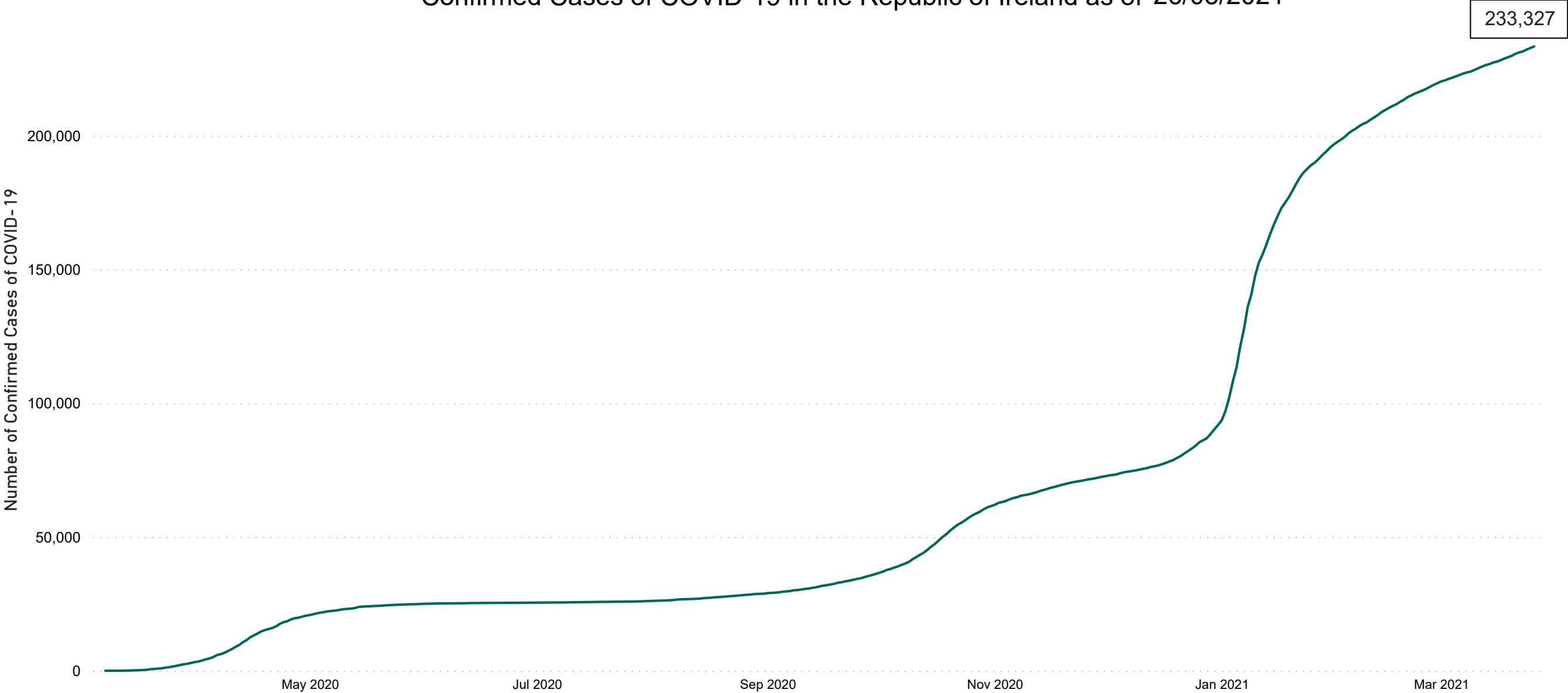
% Increase in total confirmed cases compared to the previous day since 06 March

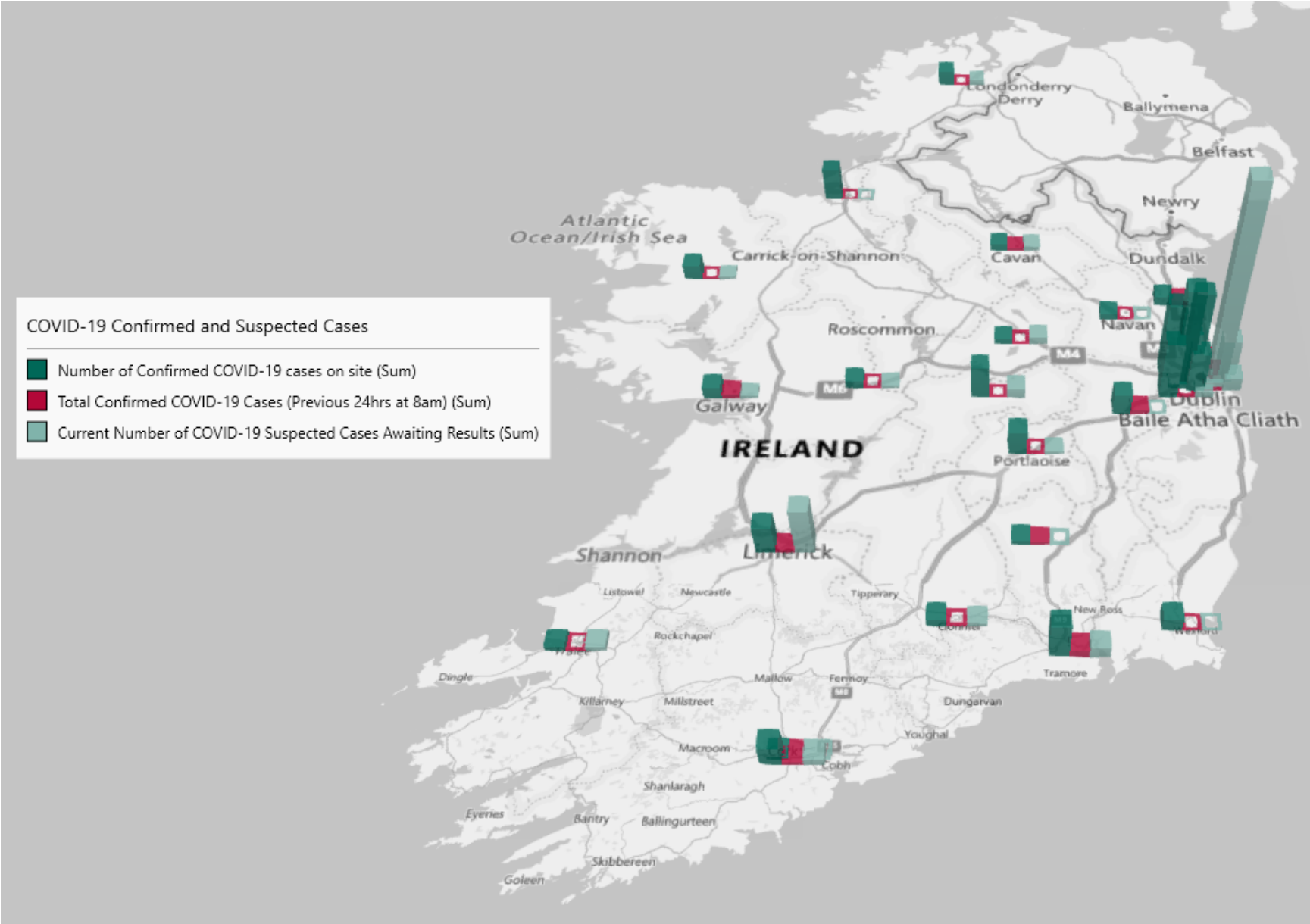

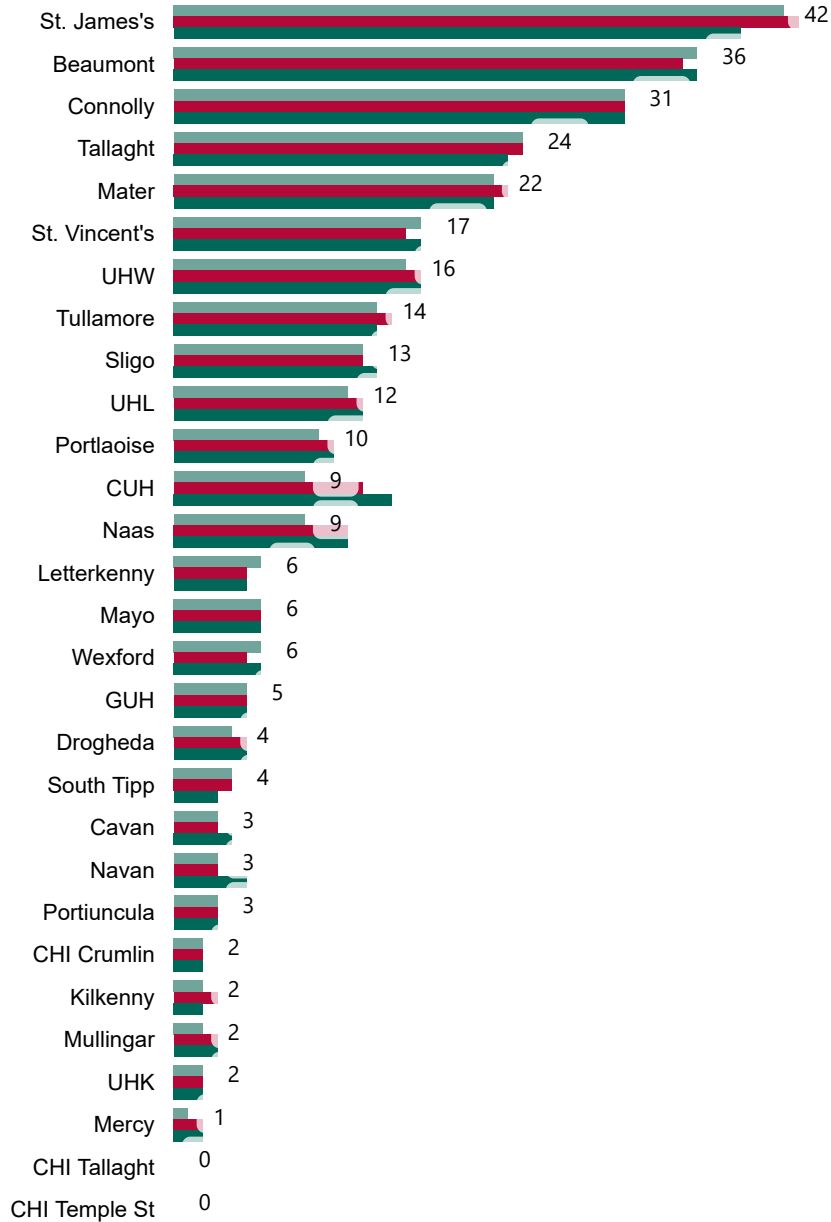

# Geographical Spread of COVID-19 Confirmed Cases and Suspected Cases across Acute Hospital Sites as at 26/03/2021 20:00



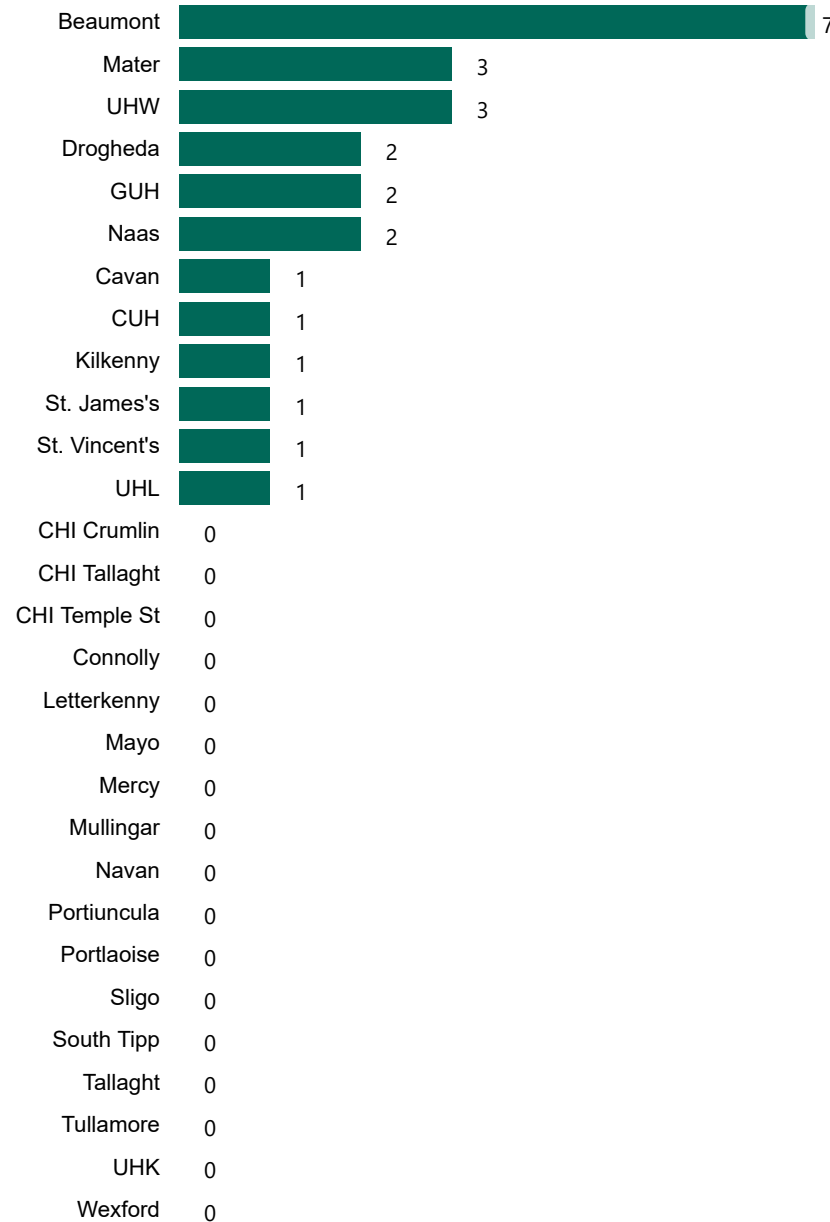

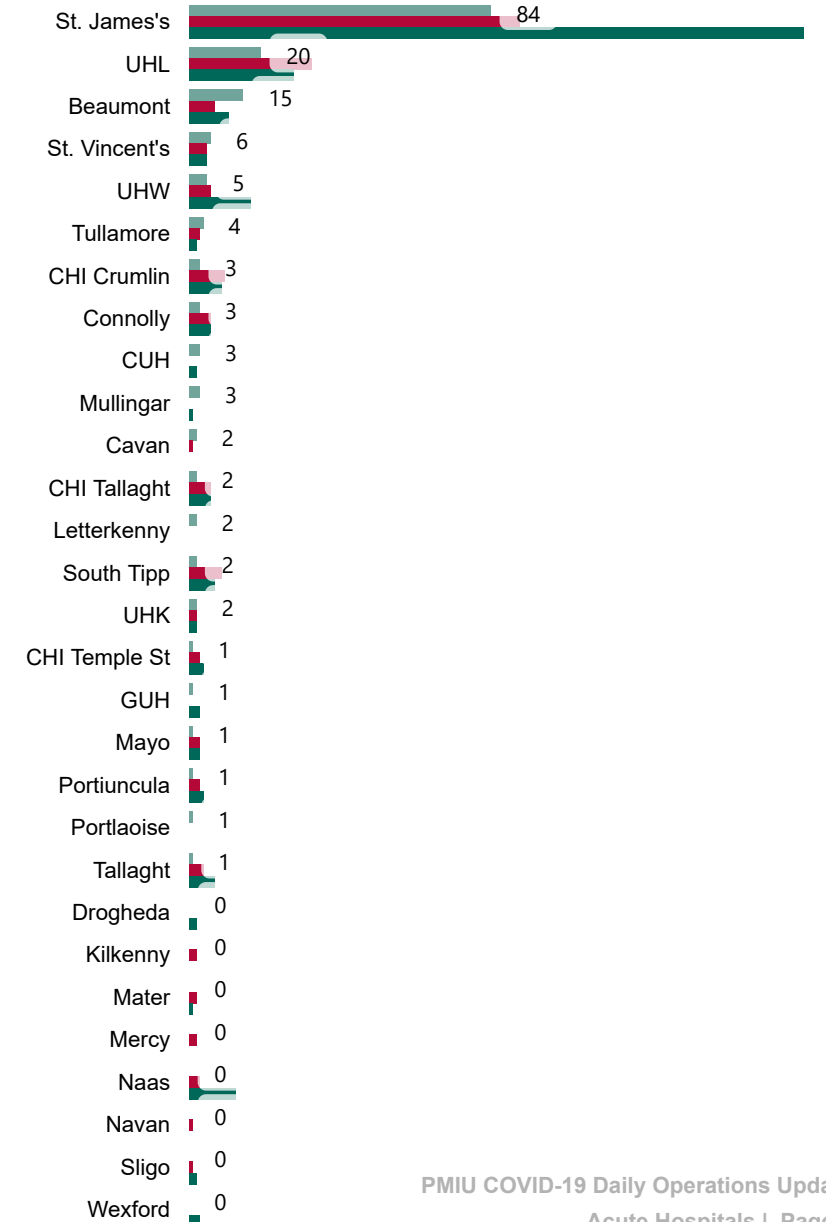

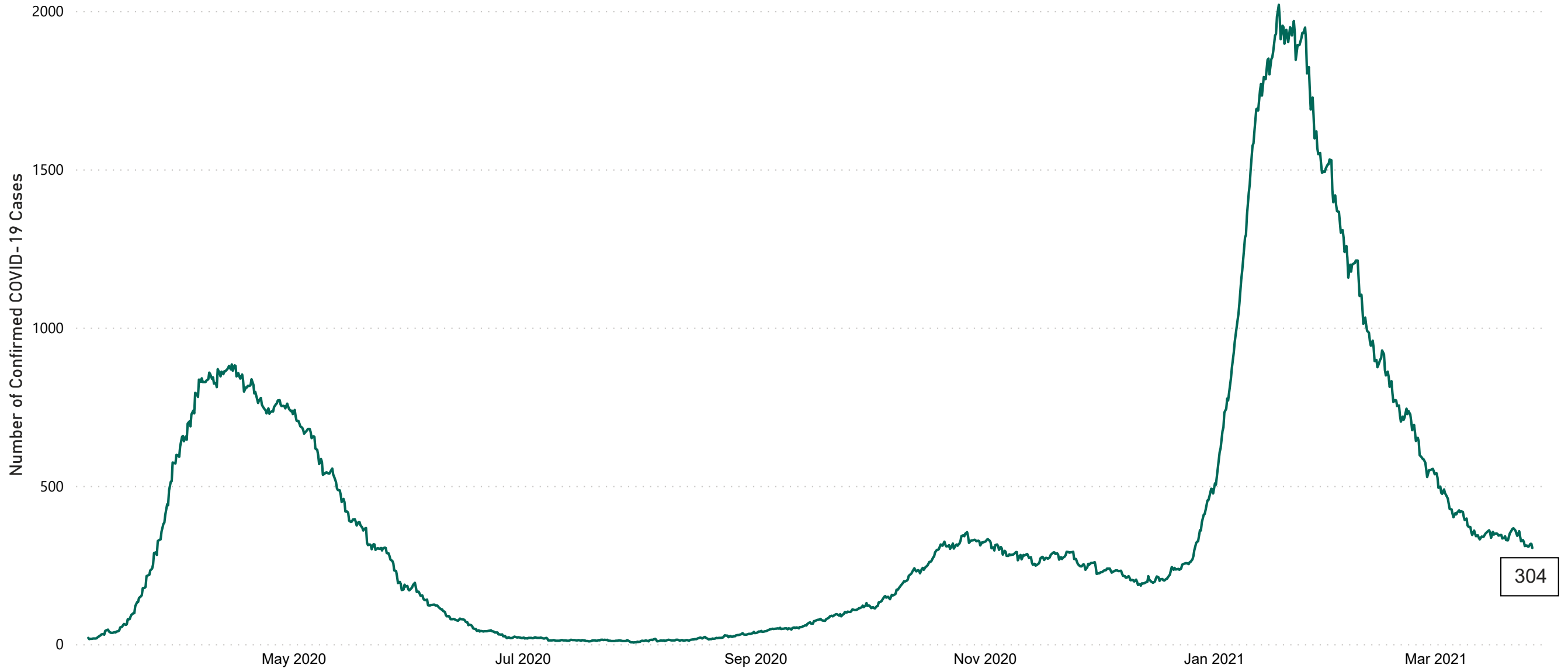

# Number of Confirmed COVID-19 Cases Admitted across 29 acute sites (including CHI)

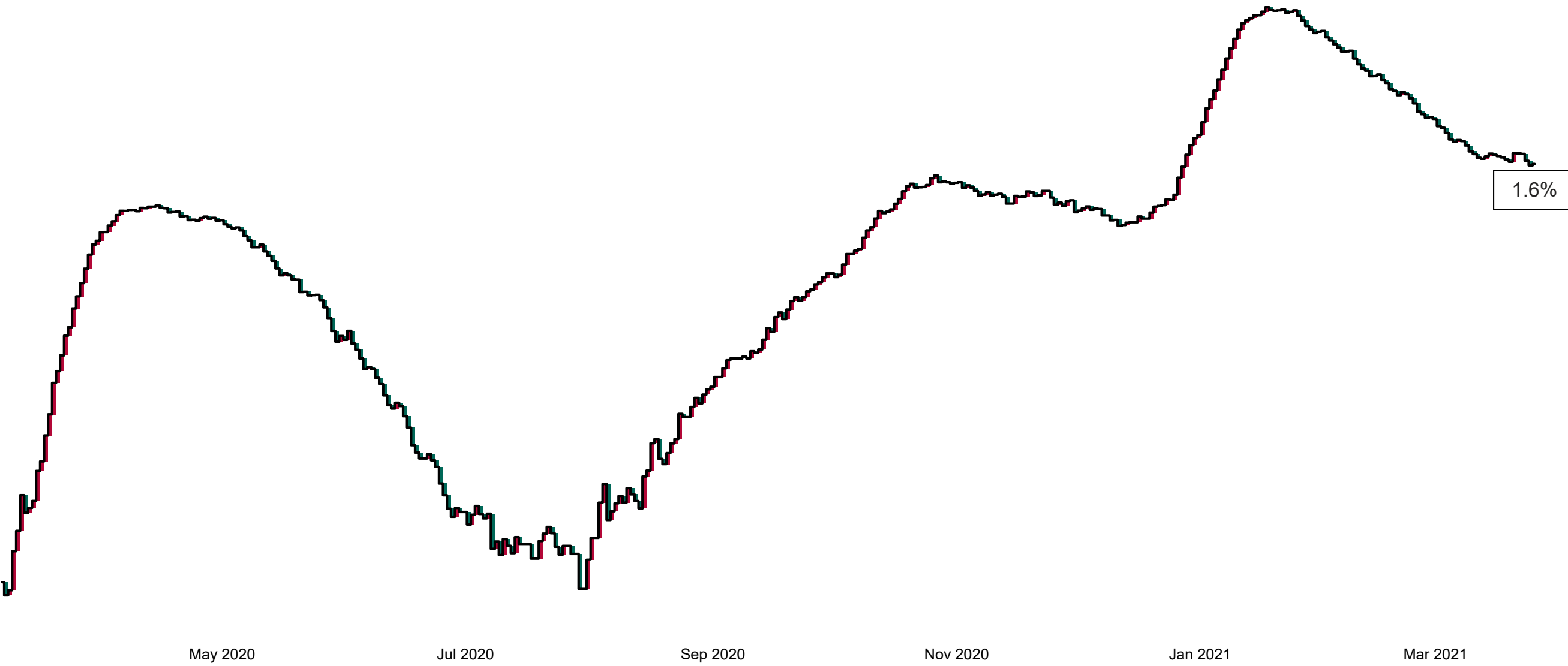

# Percentage Variance at 8am of Confirmed COVID-19 cases Admitted Across 29 sites compared to the previous day

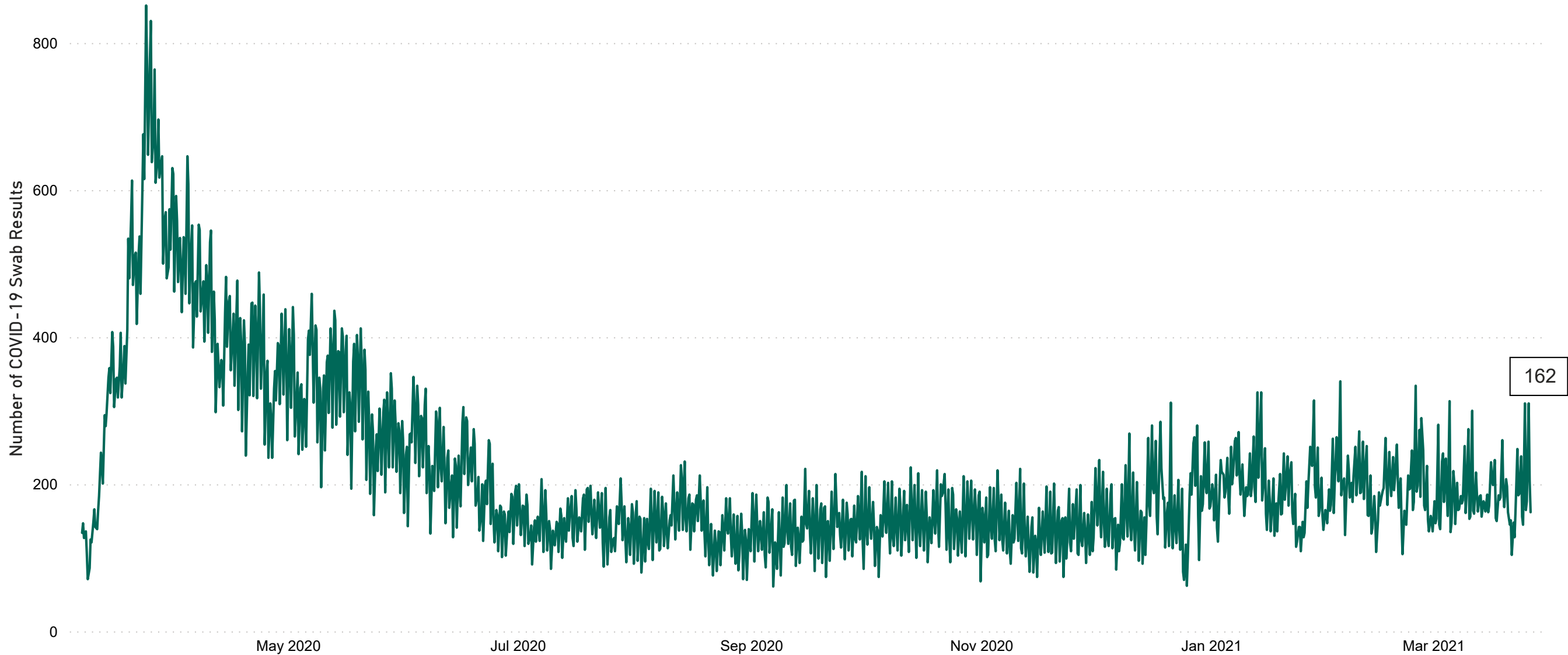

# Number of Suspected COVID-19 Swab Results Awaited Across 29 acute sites as at 26/03/2021

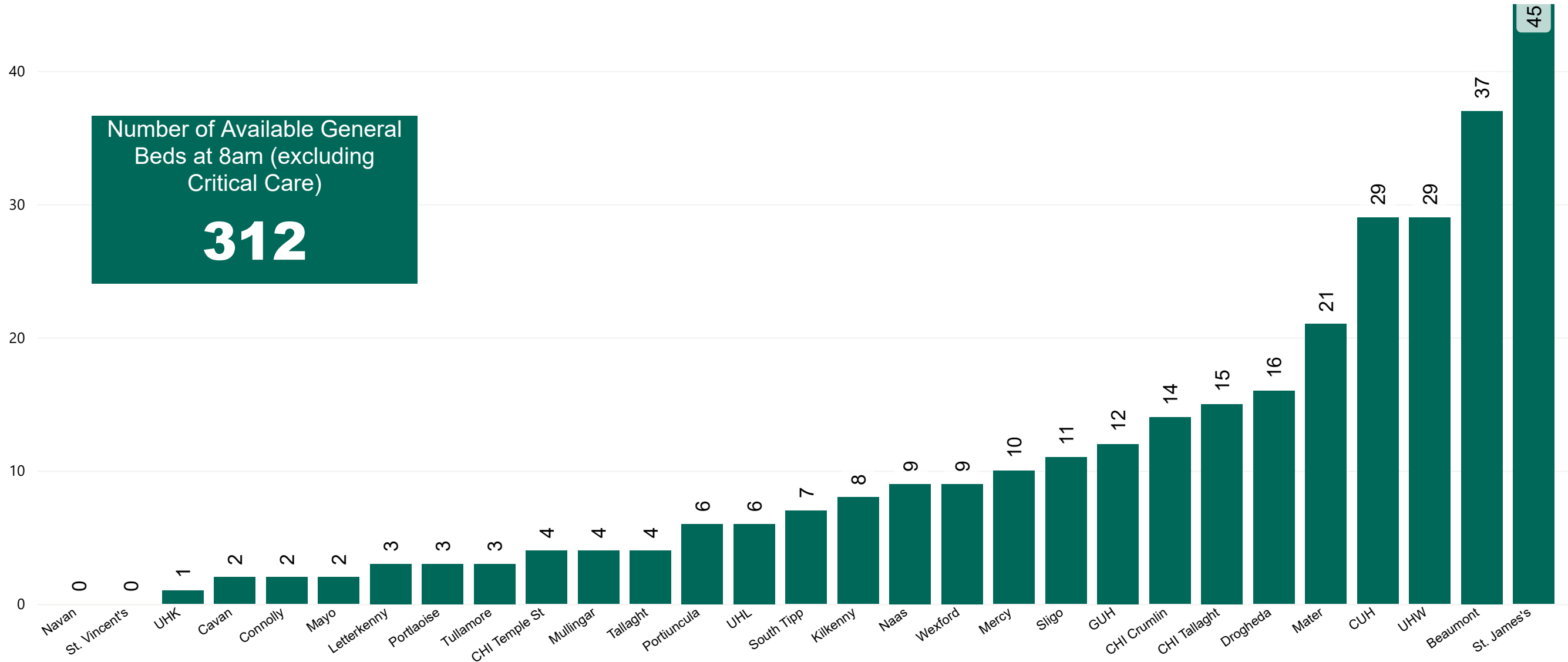

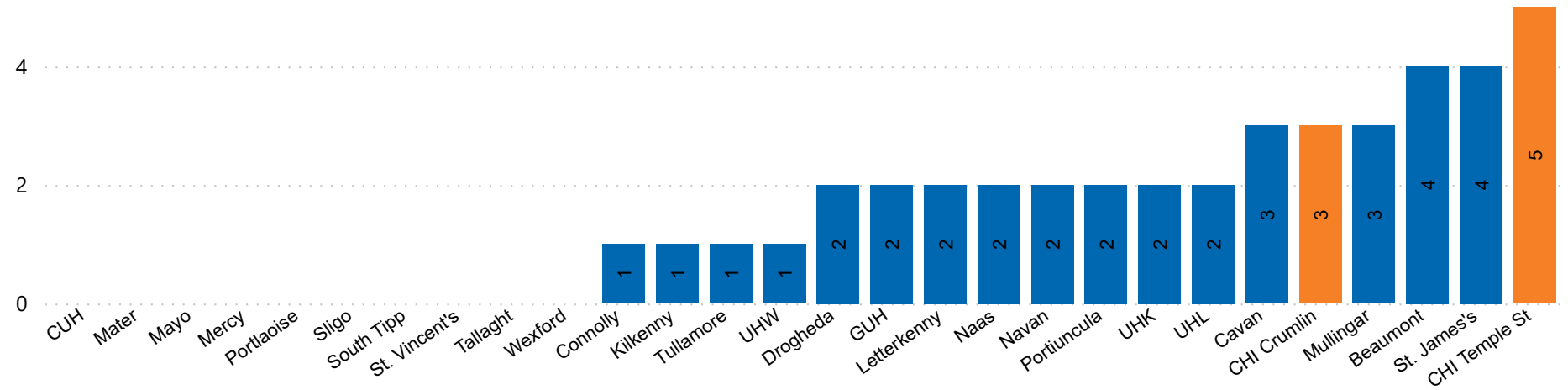

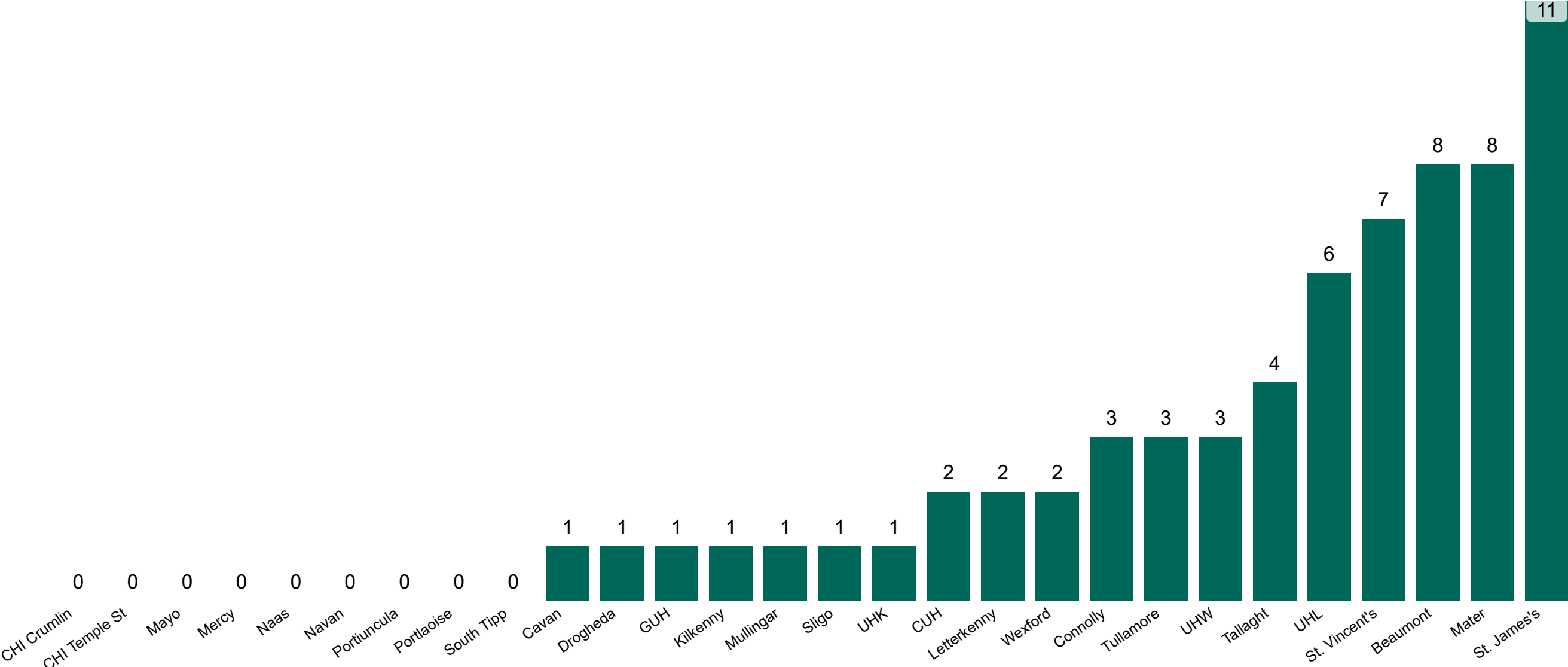

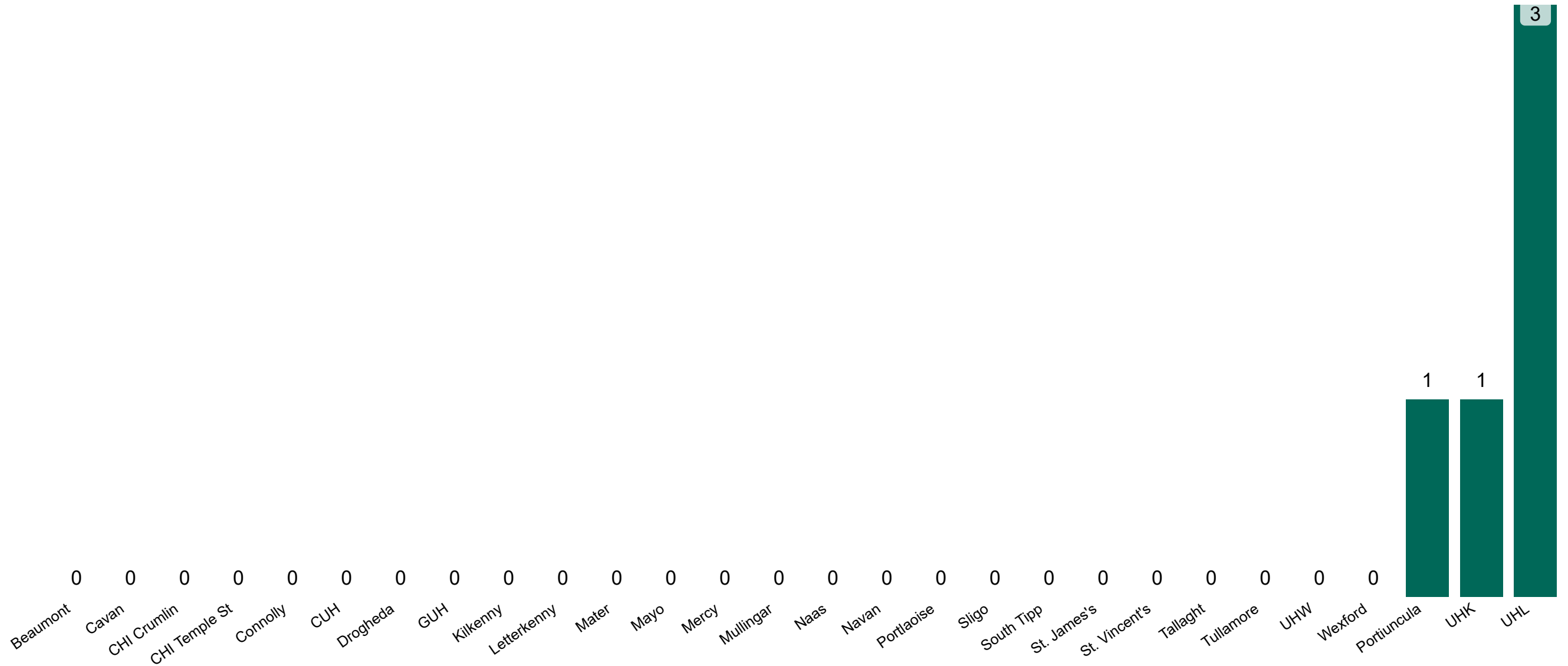
Confirmed COVID-19 Cases in Critical Care Units from 27/03/2020 to 26/03/2021

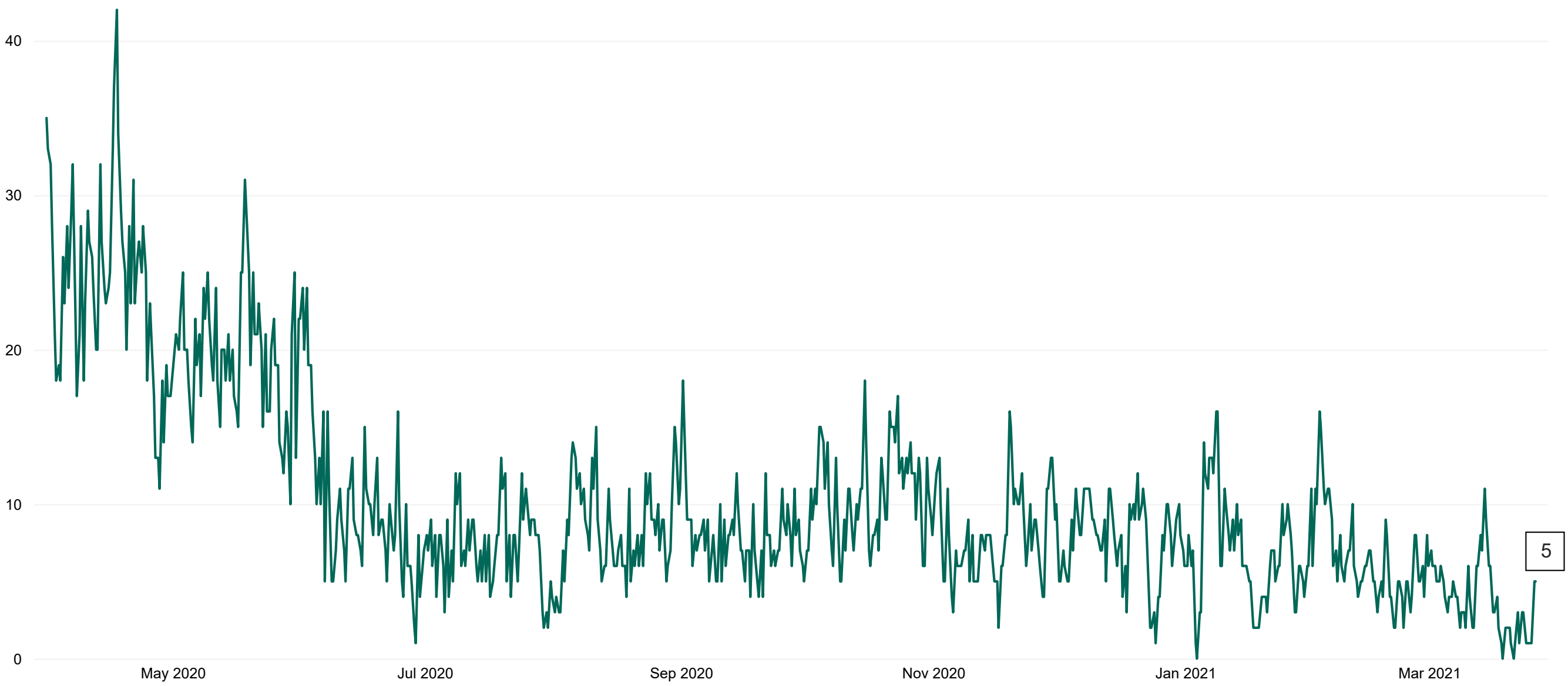
