1. Testing Volumes and Turnaround Times



Test and Trace Volumes

The following metrics and turnaround times refer to the seven days from 26th May – 1st June.



• Total Community Referrals (including walk-ins) were c.72,633, which has increased by 9.5% in comparison to the same time-frame last week (19th – 25th May; c.66,300 total referrals).



Total Swabs Completed

From the 26th May – 1st June, c.130,740 swabs were completed across community, walk-in, serial testing and acute sites.



Lab Tests and Detected Rate from 26th May – 1st June

- There was c.131,823 lab tests completed over the past week.
- The average detected rate over the past week is **approximately 2.9%**



Contact Tracing

- Over the last 7 days, of those tested with close contacts, the average number close contacts was 3.6 per person.
- From 26th May 1st June a total of 2,654 calls were completed to inform individuals of their detected COVID-19 test result.
- From 26th May 1st June, contact tracing was completed for c.2,542 individuals that had a confirmed COVID-19 case
- In addition, c.6,215 calls were made to close contacts.



Test and Trace Turnaround Times

The following metrics and turnaround times refer to the 7 day date range from 26th May – 1st June.



Turnaround Times

- The combined median time from swab to lab result in community and acute settings was 22 hours.
- All contact tracing calls are completed within a mean of 8.6 hours and a median of 5.6 hours.
- In the last seven days, in the community, we have delivered a median end to end turnaround time of 1 day for not detected results.
- In the last seven days, in the community, we have delivered a median end to end turnaround time of 1.3 days for detected results.





2. Testing and Trace Trends



Total Community Referrals

(Including walk-ins)

- From the 26th May 1st June, there were a total of c.72,633 Community Referrals (including walkins). This weekly total has increased by 9.5% in comparison to the same time-period last week (19th 25th May; c.60,300 total referrals).
- The graph to the right shows a daily breakdown
 of total community and walk-in referrals over
 the past 7 days.

Total Referrals 26th May - 1st June






Overall Positivity Trend




- The positivity rate for the past seven days is c.2.9%
- The positivity rate has remained consistent in comparison to the same time-period last week (2.9%)

Serial Testing in Nursing Homes

Cycle 12 of serial testing for Nursing Homes commenced on 24th of May.




9 facilities have been tested



Mandatory Hotel Quarantine Testing

- All passengers arriving into Ireland from designated states are required to pre-book accommodation in a designated quarantine facility.
- Testing resources have been made available in Quarantine Facilities since 26th March 2021, and are available on a daily basis to accommodate the testing of all new arrivals.
- The scope of testing includes:
 - Testing of passengers arriving into Ireland from Category 2 Countries on Day 0 and Day 10
 - Testing of passengers arriving into Ireland from Category 1 Countries that have not been able to produce a negative result
 - Testing of Quarantine Hotel Staff on a weekly basis

Of these 938 staff; 885 of these staff have been hired and retained as part of dedicated workforce to support the contact tracing function

The remaining 53 staff are redeployed from the HSE and other Public Service Roles





Self-Referral Portal Pilot

- The Self-Referral Portal Pilot began in Letterkenny, Swords and Citywest testing centres on Tuesday 1st of June 2021.
- Individuals in the Pilot areas will now be able to access the online system and book their COVID 19 test up to 24 hours in advance, whether symptomatic or asymptomatic
- Work is currently underway to enable this system to be rolled out across all of the static testing sites.





As of the 1st of June, the overall positivity rate is 2.9%.



Our median end to end turnaround time is 1.3 days for detected cases and 1 day for not detected cases.



Total Community Referral Volumes have increased by 9.5% in comparison to the same time-period last week
