1. Testing Volumes and Turnaround Times



Test and Trace Volumes

The following metrics and turnaround times refer to the seven days from 19th – 25th May.



• Total Community Referrals (including walk-ins) were c.66,307, which has increased by 39% in comparison to the same time-frame last week (12th – 18th May; c.47,783 total referrals).



Total Swabs Completed

From the 19th – 25th of May, c.129,245 swabs were completed across community, walk-in, serial testing and acute sites.



Lab Tests and Detected Rate from 19th – 25th May

- There was c.134,644 lab tests completed in community and private settings over the past week.
- The average detected rate over the past week is **approximately 2.9%**.



Contact Tracing

- Over the last 7 days, of those tested with close contacts, the average number close contacts was 3.5 per person.
- From 19th 25th May a total of 2,887 calls were completed to inform individuals of their detected COVID-19 test result.
- From 19th 25th May, contact tracing was completed for c.2,656 individuals that had a confirmed COVID-19 case
- In addition, c.6,481 calls were made to close contacts.



Test and Trace Turnaround Times

The following metrics and turnaround times refer to the 7 day date range from 19th – 25th May.



Turnaround Times

- The combined median time from swab to lab result in community and acute settings was 23 hours.
- All contact tracing calls are completed within a mean of 8.7 hours and a median of 6.2 hours.
- In the last seven days, in the community, we have delivered a median end to end turnaround time of 1 day for not detected results.
- In the last seven days, in the community, we have delivered a median end to end turnaround time of 1.7 days for detected results.






2. Testing and Trace Trends



Total Community Referrals

(Including walk-ins)

- From the 19th 25th May, there were a total of c.66,307 Community Referrals (including walkins). This weekly total has increased by 39% in comparison to the same time-period last week (12th 18th May; c.47,783 total referrals).

 of total community and walk-in referrals over
 the past 7 days.





Overall Positivity Trend




- The positivity rate for the past seven days is c.2.9%
- The positivity rate has increased slightly in comparison to the same time-period last week (2.4%)



Close Contacts Trend

Over the last 7 days, of those tested with at least one close contact, the mean number of close contacts per person was 3.5

Serial Testing in Nursing Homes

Cycle 12 of serial testing for Nursing Homes commenced on 24th of May.






72 facilities have been tested

Mandatory Hotel Quarantine Testing

- All passengers arriving into Ireland from designated states are required to pre-book accommodation in a designated quarantine facility.
- Testing resources have been made available in Quarantine Facilities since 26th March 2021, and are available on a daily basis to accommodate the testing of all new arrivals.
- The scope of testing includes:
 - Testing of passengers arriving into Ireland from Category 2 Countries on Day 0 and Day 10
 - Testing of passengers arriving into Ireland from Category 1 Countries that have not been able to produce a negative result
 - Testing of Quarantine Hotel Staff on a weekly basis

Of these 938 staff; 885 of these staff have been hired and retained as part of dedicated workforce to support the contact tracing function

The remaining 53 staff are redeployed from the HSE and other Public Service Roles





Testing for Close Contacts

 Close contacts, including school close contacts, are now once again receiving a text message with details of where and when they need to get their COVID-19 test.

• It is vitally important from a Public Health Management perspective, that these individuals attend for their test appointment as outlined in the text message, rather than attend a walk-in test centre without an appointment.





As of the 25th of May, the overall **positivity rate is 2.9%.**



Our median end to end turnaround time is 1.7 days for detected cases and 1 day for not detected cases.



Total Community Referral Volumes have increased by 39% in comparison to the same time-period last week
