As of 30/05/2020, 210 employees had been identified as COVID-19 positive in the month of May, with a further 30 identified as of Friday. A number of close contacts have been identified within the home settings. There appears to be no wider transmission within the general local community. 4 lab confirmed cases (1 employee & 3 contacts) are currently being treated in ICU. Public Health and Environmental Health continues to engage with the employer to implement safe systems of work to mitigate risk to employees from transmission of COVID- 19.
