	Epidemiological update. Apologies from KK and LD. Abridged Public Health Epi Update circulated via email this morning.  7,935 cases over last 14-day period. Median age 32yrs. 73.5% of cases <45yrs. National incidence rate of 166.64/100K. Counties with the highest 14-day incidence rate are Offaly at 511/100K, Donegal at 286/100K and Westmeath at 258/100K. Hospitalisations: 330. Brittany variant –concern regarding vaccination and PCR testing, government reviewing the mandatory hotel quarantine of travellers from France.

	Majority of COVID-19 cases (88%) are concentrated in 4 hospitals in the East of the country, these areas are experiencing high case numbers in the community too.  Number of staff on COVID-19 related leave remains low.		
8. TESTING & TRACING			
	Testing Walk-in Testing Centres: > 22,000 tests completed, with 506 positive cases (2.3% positivity). Majority of attendees are aged between 25-44 with highest positivity between those aged 15-24 (4.3%).  Different levels of positivity at different sites. The results are being assessed and reviewed by Public Health. Reminder that this is not a population study of asymptomatic cases, as on questioning it has been discovered that not all those presenting are asymptomatic, or those presenting are close contacts of a confirmed positive case.  Meeting scheduled with Public Health for later today to discuss future plans.		Niamh O'Beirne
