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	Dublin at 179/100K and Offaly at 171/100K. 187 healthcare worker cases. 4.4% positivity rate yesterday, compared to 4% a week ago. 8 deaths notified to HPSC from public health department since Friday 14/05/21. Mean age of 67. Outbreaks- Week 19: 21 in schools. 3 in childcare facilities. 1 in hotels. 1 in third level institution. 1 in direct provision. Variants of Concern: 72 cases of the South African variant identified in Ireland, of which 8 were community transmission. 28 cases of the Brazilian variant identified in Ireland. 89 cases of the Indian variant identified in Ireland, of which 8 were community transmission.
