

Creating chances to Chat



To make chances for small people to chat, use toys that are hard to work like wind up toys or put toys inside a hard to open box.

They will need to ask you for help to open the box or make the toy work.



Your child may tell you they need help by pointing, using gestures, making sounds or saying words.

As a parent you are really good at knowing what your child needs and wants, so sometimes your child doesn't have a reason to communicate.

But, when we use toys which are hard to work, turn on or open, we are creating a chance for them to communicate and chat with us.

This helps them to learn to talk.
