

Too many questions stop the play!



When you play with your child try not asking too many questions as they can stop the play!

Change: 'Are you driving the tractor?'

To: **'you are driving the tractor.'**



It is natural for us to want to ask children lots of questions because we want to hear them speak and use their words.

Too many questions can make them cross because it feels like a test.



They are still only learning to talk so give them lots of words and sentences to listen to.

That's the best way to help them learn to say them.



Change: "Are you making me tea?"

To: "I would like a cup of tea,

You make the best tea!"



Change: "Do you like cake?"

To: "You made a cake!

It's yummy cake"
