

Lots of words for lots of things



Using lots of words for lots of things is a great tip for helping little ones to talk.

Name the toy your little one is looking at or playing with.

Name the actions they are doing with it.



Try to do this when they are holding them or doing it as this will help your little one understand what the words mean. They will link the word with the action or thing.

When your little one hands you something instead of saying 'thank you' say the name instead.

Try to add describing words to names to help your little ones understand and put words together too.

Don't forget naming feelings as they have them: Happy, sad, cross, tired. This is really important to help your little one learn the words they need to describe how they feel.
