Summary Findings of Current Nursing Home Inspection

- Under Care & Staffing the nursing home was compliant with 24 out of 25 regulations.**
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, there are issues that need to be addressed as outlined below in relation to the Care and Staffing.
- Under Management the nursing home was compliant with 23 out of 23 regulations.**
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, the inspection team would consider the nursing home to have a good standard of management.
- Under Physical Environment the nursing home was compliant with 10 out of 11 regulations.**
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, there are issues that need to be addressed as outlined below in relation to the Physical Environment.

Regulation number	14. The registered proprietor and the person in charge of the nursing home shall:— (b) make adequate arrangements for the prevention of infection, infestation, toxic conditions, or spread of infection and infestation at the nursing home;
Non-Compliance	Patients' clean clothes and clean incontinence pads were left on the window sill in a shared toilet.
Required Action	Clothes and pads to be removed. Ensure that all nursing and care staff have read the infection control policy and are trained in it's implementation.
Timescale	Immediate on receipt of this report.

Regulation number	19.1 In every nursing home the following particulars shall be kept in a safe place in respect of each dependent person:— (f) a record of drugs and medicines administered giving the date of the prescription, dosage, name of the drug or medicine, method of administration, signed and dated by a medical practitioner and the nurse administering the drugs and medicines;
Non-Compliance	In the case of one patient the time of administration of a drug had been changed but the change had not been dated or signed by the doctor.

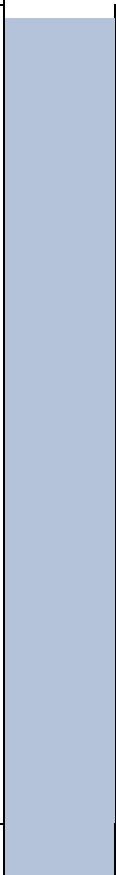

	<p>Non-Compliance (1)The wall behind the toilet in the sluice room was badly stained; (2) The window blinds in room 2 were torn; (3) The flooring in room 1 and the upper floor dayroom was cracked. (4) The paint on the pipe insulation above the sink in the sluice room was cracked and peeling; (5) Several hooks were missing from the curtains in the Board Room.</p>
	<p>Required Action (1) wall to be painted (2) blinds to be replaced (3) Flooring to be replaced. (4) Pipe to be painted. (5) Curtains to be rehung.</p>
	<p>Timescale (1) (4) and (5) immediate on receipt of this report. (2) and (3) within 6 weeks of receipt of this report.</p>
