Comments and recommendations made by the inspection team as a result of the inspection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Storage space remains an issue and consideration should be given to its provision and to this end the Team suggest the conversion of a room into a dedicated storage area.</li><li>In the interest of health and safety it is suggested that the present security system be reassessed and upgraded if found necessary.</li><li>From a safety perspective staff are advised to ensure that the call bell system is fully functional on a daily basis especially on the first floor.</li></ul>		Recommendations
