Comments and recommendations made by the inspection team as a result of the inspection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Following assessment, consultation and clear guidelines, consent for restraint of residents should be documented prior to its implementation. The Team commend the improved format of documentation but recommend more frequent assessment and updating. Items which are not associated with sluicing activities shall not be stored in the sluice rooms. It is strongly recommended that sluice rooms and sanitary facilities are fitted with lockable cupboards for the safe storage of cleaning chemicals and other miscellaneous items.
