Comments and recommendations made by the inspection team as a result of the inspection	 As discussed during inspection, it is recommended that a new shower curtain is fitted in the ground floor bathroom, that the walls and ceiling of this room are repainted and that the broken light shade is replaced. The cause of the leak in the sluice room needs to be investigated and remedied. The sluice room is in need of redecoration i.e. proper ceiling with an easily cleanable finish and a wall finish which is smooth and non-porous (in the interests of infection control).
